Description	<p>El objetivo del proyecto es profundizar en el conocimiento del concepto de paisaje desde una perspectiva transversal y al mismo tiempo adaptarse al estudio de realidades paisajísticas diferentes en el marco de grupos de trabajo de carácter multinacional. A nivel pedagógico cabe reseñar: el trabajo sobre material teórico (bibliografía y cartografía diversa), el análisis de una realidad concreta también a partir de trabajo de campo y la necesidad de exponer y defender planteamientos en las sesiones de debate con agentes sociales implicados y con los mismos estudiantes participantes en el IP. El objetivo ser capaces de analizar desde una perspectiva de complejidad las realidades paisajística con capacidad de introducir conceptos y métodos propios de la dimensión cultural y también física en el marco de grupos de trabajo multinacionales que asimilan a un análisis de carácter europeo y que pueden facilitar la integración futura de los estudiantes en equipos de trabajo de la UE. En este ámbito las TIC juegan un papel determinante tanto en la elaboración del trabajo como también en la difusión de los resultados a partir de la facilitación de la información en formato digital en una página web.</p>

Description	<p>The objective of FORTE III is to go deeply into Responsible Tourism. The focus of this IP is the promotion of responsible tourism through tourist routes. Each Higher Education Institution (HEI) will contribute to the project with its field of expertise, facilitating the analysis of tourist routes from different approaches:-TUAS (FI): Environmental.-PLANTIJN (BE): Social. -KAUNAS (LT): Cultural.-ROTTERDAM (NL): Economic. -FLORIDA (ES): Use of sustainable tools (web 2.0) to promote the tourist routes.The target group consist of bachelor students (3rd year) of Tourism, Hospitality and Marketing Management studies in the five partner institutions. Concerning the management, assessment, monitoring and dissemination of the project, we will use the procedures used for the first and the second IPs including improvements from the previous experiences.The methodology used during the IP will be "Cooperative Learning" in international groups. Description	<p>This project aims to collaboratively involve future and practising school leaders in their own professional development as critical change agents able to lead more participative and democratic schools and environments - and, hence, it aims to involve them in school and community improvement. Its objectives are: 1) to enhance interchange, collaboration and collegiality in improving learning, teaching and school leadership; 2) to promote professional development through meeting learning objectives included in the EFQ Level 7; 3) to facilitate capacity-building in schools to address current and future challenges through innovating endeavours and practices.</p> <p>The direct, primary target group benefitting from this project will be graduate students involved in Master's level school leadership development programmes delivered by the participating institutions, notwithstanding the differences in emphasis among them boosting interdisciplinary collaboration.</p> <p>Its main activities include face-to-face teaching (eleven working days) preceded by preparatory work and followed by completion of evaluation. Description	<p>Knowledge and conservation of the Built Heritage is an important issue for many sectors such as conservation scientist, geologist, environmentalist, historians, architects, engineers: the Global Heritage. Our proposal aims to combine the knowledge of several of this professionals coming from four European Universities, to form students at a Master level, preparing them as the next generation of researchers with the conceptual and methodological tools and skills necessary for analyzing the state of the art of the field of Built Heritage and contribute to the conservation and diffusion of its importance around the world. The IP is offered to graduate students in Geology, Engineering Geology, Architecture, Environmentalists and subjects related. Description	<p>Taking into account results of the undertaken Destination Analysis IP, we found the need to increase consciousness towards sustainable tourism. Therefore the new programme will focus on how to identify the existing Tourism situation within various destinations and formulate and implement sustainable development plans. It will also give students valuable experience at working as part of an international team. Undergraduate final year Tourism students from Finland, Spain and UK will be brought together to study Sustainable Tourism Management. The project consortium: The University of Salford, Universitat Jaume I, and Tampere University of Applied Sciences. 14 Tourism students from each partner will be represented on this programme which will run for three years on a rotational basis with a different cohort of students.
