Description	<p>Information technology and communication play an important role in our society. Hence securing these concepts is vital to our society. The concrete application would be adopted in the field of security, namely security threats and assets, forensics and fraud detection. Students in information technology with a background knowledge in operating systems and networking are the target audience. The total number of students is 48 and 10 lecturers will teach in the IP. There are 9 European partners in the project. The partners of the project are:1.Yasar University, Turkey2. XIOS Hogeschool Limburg, Belgium3. Katholieke Hogeschool Leuven, Belgium4. Universidad del Pais Vasco, Spain5. Setubal Polytechnic Institute6. College of Management and Public Adm in Zamosc7. Fachhochschule St.Pölten, Austria8. Bournemouth University, UK9. Vilnius UNiversity, LithuaniaThe IP has been approved in 2008 and it is successfully implemented by Universidad del Pais Vasco in Spain. The renewed IP is going to be implemented in April 20110 at St.Pölten, Austria. The IP has been implemented in other partners due to the lack of adequate facilities of Yasar University in terms of laboratories' capacity. This year, the university has already moved to a new campus with very modern facilities, new dormitory and proper environment needed for this project. As being the coordinator of the project in the last 2 years, Yaşar University would like to host and organize the IP for the first time in Turkey. IP entiteled "Network Discovery and 4n6" (NetDisc) is planned to take place between the dates 17-29 April 2010at Yaşar University, Izmir. The number of expected students is 48 and 10 lecturers. The main activities would be in the area of prevention, detection and investigation. As ICT has a meaning of its own in each country it is important to compare the different views and perspectives. So the different approaches to security in the different countries will be compared in order to reach a consensus of what is a good working security practice. Using this consensus the students will work on a forensics case and in this process they will discuss and set the limits of what is ethical; which can be quite different depending on the student's cultural background. The IP will create new teaching material in the field of computer security. The teaching material will be published and delivered to the participants. The teaching material will also be published on the project's website. The project will be disseminated by all the partners. Moreover, with the accumulated international contribution up to now, this IP mainly aims to publish a text book as the main output this renewed IP and incorporate this course the educational programmes of the partners. As expected output the students should be able to use and report on the consensus working practice. On the condition to fully participate to the IP, the students will get 5 ECTS and this can also be graded upon the consideration of each partner by taking into account the assessment results done by the participating lecturers and students.</p>

Description	<p>The objective of this programme is to assess and understand how cultural landscapes have evolved over time and can be related to specific determining factors in local and wider European context and how cultural heritage can be integrated into education, research, professional, administrative and political practice. Contextual academic materials and logistical information will be provided on a dedicated programme web site. The target group is both undergraduate and postgraduate students from the partner countries who are studying landscape-related issues in academic programmes combining analytical and conceptual approaches. Main activities will include: 1). Theoretical lectures on the assessment of the cultural aspects of landscapes, 2). Theoretical lectures on the evolution of design ideas from cultural values, 3). Field studies to observe the traces and structures of historic and contemporary Cultural Landscapes, 4). Studio works on the creation of landscape design projects with the inspiration of time and space dimension of the cultural landscape. 5) Integration of stakeholders professionally involved in the maintenance and development of Cultural Landscapes as sources of information, partners in discussion and dissemination. The expected outputs of the intensive programme are as follows: Prior to the programme:- Web site to provide contextual and organizational information to participants. - Teaching materials to be used during the programme, including formal lectures, workshop sessions, problem-based learning briefing notes, and key skills guidance (e.g. team working, research methods). During the programme:- An image bank will be compiled by students and staff to support research undertaken during the programme, to illustrate the virtual field course, and provide a teaching resource. - Primary and secondary data collected by students and staff, including geo-data, historical maps, photographs and surveys, interview transcripts, questionnaire surveys, and other materials. - Intermediate and final student presentations in public. - Student and staff reflective diaries to provide a basis for a pedagogic evaluation of the implementation of the IP. After the programme:- The virtual field course to Antalya will be developed using many of the outputs produced prior to and during the programme. - Dissemination of the results of the programme will be undertaken through journal articles, conference presentations and through individual and collective networks. - IP results will form the basis of students' thesis and dissertation work oriented towards refined local conservation, management and development concepts, European comparisons and reflection of teaching and research methods.</p>
