Recovery may come but we'll never be the same....

- There may be lots of work but not many jobs
- Fuzzier distinctions between public, private and third sector organisations
- Trust has been shaken in large '*too big to fail*' organisations, political and financial leaders
- Technology provides ordinary people with more power to complain and influence policies
- Technology also increases the kinds of work that can be accomplished as tasks or projects anytime, anywhere, at the best price

Understanding graduate entrepreneurs

- More drawn from arts and humanities – not science, engineering & technology or business administration
- Not in it solely for money – more important is personal development, job satisfaction & social issues
- Bulk of graduate entrepreneurs are relatively poor but happy

- 35% of all early stage entrepreneurs in the UK now looking to start a social venture

(Social Entrepreneurship in the UK, 2008, Global Entrepreneurship Monitor)

- Annual financial turnovers of social enterprise projects growing almost twice as quickly as those of traditional businesses

(Comparison made by Social Enterprise Magazine of the top 40 companies)

- About 10% of the Cass Business School MBA students are from the third sector or hoping to work in the field
