ECVET objectives, from the point of view of the learner:

- ➔ Facilitate accumulation of learning outcomes
- ➔ Facilitate access to qualifications
- ➔ Facilitate access to lifelong learning
- ➔ Support reintegration of low skilled people
- ➔ Facilitate mobility and borderless lifelong learning in Europe

Using ECVET: what does it mean?

- ➔ **Learning:** knowledge, skills and competences
- ➔ **Assessment:** identifying and assessing learning outcomes
- ➔ **Validation:** outcomes related to a unit and/or a qualification
- ➔ **Recognition:** officially awarding of units and/or a qualification
- ➔ **Accumulation:** units are taken into account by addition to obtain a qualification

**How is it possible to use this
unit based approach?**

KEY Question 1

How can you carry out the accumulation of learning outcomes in a mobility and mobilizing context:

- ① how the process should look like?
- ② what does it mean in term of flexibility of the different qualifications and awarding systems?
- ③ how assessment and validation of learning outcomes acquired in non-formal and informal learning can be taken into account?
