Objectives and description of the action

The aim of **Leonardo da Vinci Multilateral Projects 'Transfer of Innovation'** is the adaptation of innovative content from the previous Leonardo da Vinci Programme, and or the integration of the results and the lessons learnt from the Leonardo da Vinci and other innovative projects into public and/or private vocational training systems and companies at the local, regional, national and/or Community level.

The process for transferring innovative training content has a number of steps which go beyond dissemination, and which are described below:

- Identifying and analysing targeted user requirements
- Selecting and analysing innovative content to meet these requirements and analysing its [transferability](#)
- Adapting it to the training systems, culture, needs and requirements of potential users (updating the product, translation, etc.)
- Transferring it to new socio-cultural and linguistic contexts (target groups, sectors, etc.)
- Using it in new sectors, with new target groups, including piloting it in public or private training structures
- Integrating (or certifying) it in regional, national, European and/or sectoral training systems and practices.
