European Legal Practice - LL.M. Eur

**Duration** : 3 years

**Summary description**

The Erasmus-Mundus consortium "European Legal Practice" (Universities of Hannover, Le Havre, Rouen and Lisbon) plans to enlarge its project by five additional non-EU partners for three years:

- Chulalongkorn University, Bangkok (Thailand)
- Union Educacional do Planalto Central, Brasilia (Brazil)
- Symbiosis Society's Law College Pune (India)
- Jiao Tong University, Shanghai (China)
- Northwest Institute for Political Science and Law, Xian (China).

The participating nine EU- und Non-EU-universities have developed a network, which deepens the mutual knowledge of the national legal systems and encourages research on comparative legal issues. At the non-EU-universities, visiting professors and students from the EU partners will familiarise with the respective national legal system and culture, particularly with reference to internationally relevant aspects.

At the non-EU universities, a total of 22 EU scholars will teach and conduct research on relevant legal topics, especially on-commercial law, labour law, human rights, constitutional law, international and comparative law.

Integrated foreign studies of 2 to 3 months are planned for 64 European Erasmus Mundus students in universities of a third country (14 mobilities in 2006, 20 in 2007, 30 in 2008). The recognition of non-European ECTS-credits is an integral part of the following mobility scheme:

First Semester at the first EU host university (30 ECTS); second semester at the second EU host university (30 ECTS); July – September (or: Aug- Oct): studies at a non-EU partner university (= 12 ECTS); third semester: return to the first EU host university (24 ECTS); fourth semester at the first EU host university for writing the Master thesis (24 ECTS).

By cooperating with the five new non-European partners in this mobility-scheme, the Erasmus Mundus-Course "European Legal Practice" will receive an international Non-European perspective and will enhance its attractiveness.
