The overall aim of BalticStudyNet is to promote higher education in the Baltic Sea Region (BSR) outside the EU and to develop tools for academic training according to existing needs. The focus is on study and research programmes dealing with political, economic and cultural perspectives on the BSR.

One of the central activities of BalticStudyNet is the spreading of information on BSR and related studies. It is made accessible at the internet portal www.balticstudy.net as well as in print.

Conferences, workshops and summer schools addressing higher education institutions, scholars and students serve to map BSR higher education, design strategies of promoting existing study programmes, develop new curricula, as well as impart basic knowledge on the BSR and the possibilities of study and research concerning the region. By learning about the possibilities of study and research in and on the BSR, students, scholars and higher education institutions from third countries benefit for their academic work. Higher education institutions in the BSR benefit from a growing influx of international students and researchers. Higher education institutions in the BSR implement the project's outcomes, such as ways and channels of advertising the attractiveness of the study and research possibilities they offer. This includes innovative curricula designed to meet and raise the interest in the region among third country students and scholars.
