

Title of the project

ENATIS - Enhancing attractiveness through international student services

Duration : 18 months

Project description

The **overall objective** of the proposed project is to enhance the attractiveness of European higher education globally, by addressing an area of student life often neglected or not strategically approached by European higher education institutions. The **specific concrete objectives** of the project actions are: 1) to discover the support needs of non-European degree students; 2) to provide recommendations on how to meet those needs in strategic and organisational terms; 3) propose guidelines of good practice for international student support at European level.

The **main target groups** of the project are European higher education institutions, and especially staff members involved in internationalisation, student recruitment, promotion, and student services. The secondary target group are non-European degree students in European HE.

The proposal includes **three main activities** which correspond to the project's **three main outputs**:

- 1) a report on students' support needs, the impact of services on student decision making, and the strategic approaches and organisation of support at the institutional level;
- 2) **Guidelines of good practice**, targeted at institutional leaders, international officers at institutions, and national and European level higher education decision makers;
- 3) a **Seminar** of 1,5 days on the theme of international student support.
