

## What Do We Know About Continuing Vocational Education and Training at Work and at Work?

### *Abstract*

This paper outlines the findings of research on continuing vocational education and training and sets out their implications for priority setting and added value in policy interventions. It focuses on both training in the workplace for employed workers as well as active labour market programmes (ALMPs) to assist unemployed workers and others excluded from the labour market. The paper also calls attention to the information deficit in CVET and argues that public authorities, at both Member State and EU level, are particularly well placed to reduce inefficiencies deriving from that information deficit.
