culture as part of the further development of Member States' NAPs/incl.

This study will draw on existing research and data and will compare and contrast policy approaches and outcomes in a representative sample of at least six different Member States in the area of access to culture as well as taking account of international studies and experience in this area and the views of those experiencing poverty and social exclusion.

The study will:

- (i) identify the ways in which poor access to and participation in cultural services and activities can deepen and intensify poverty and social exclusion;
- (ii) identify the different barriers that prevent those at risk of poverty and social exclusion accessing cultural services and opportunities and expressing their own cultural identity;
- (iii) document the contribution that increased access to and participation in cultural activities can make to combating poverty and social exclusion;
- (iv) analyse and draw conclusions as to the different mix of cultural policies and programmes which are necessary to increase equality of access and remove barriers to participation in cultural activities;
- (v) test these conclusions by presenting a draft report at a seminar to be held in the Commission's premises (and making use of the Commission's translation services).

Consultant or researcher should have no conflict of interest and be completely independent.
