a Campaign to change the landscape of energy

Launched in 2005 and now extended until 2011, the Sustainable Energy Europe Campaign is a major tool, next to legislation and support programmes, to promote the EU's sustainable energy policy. The Campaign aims to stimulate the necessary trends towards an increase in private investment in sustainable energy technologies, to spread best practices and to build alliances among sustainable energy stakeholders serving as a platform for new ideas and actions.

The two key actors within the Sustainable Energy Europe Campaign are the Sustainable Energy Partners and the Sustainable Energy Campaign Associates. They are both designed to ensure greater visibility at the European level and more efficient spread of know-how on sustainable energy technologies.

The Sustainable Energy Europe Campaign also includes a major annual event, the European Sustainable Energy Week ^[1], and supports the organisation, during the whole year, of relevant Energy Days in all 27 Member States.
