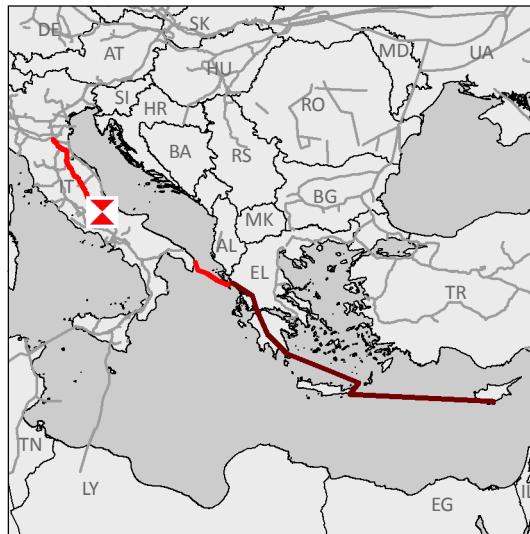

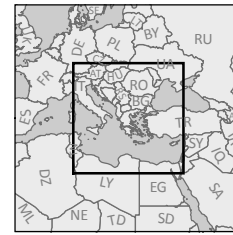
— PCI 7.3.1 - Gas pipeline

Technical description

New onshore and offshore pipeline (excluding upstream pipeline section) of approximately 1870 km.

The pipeline will have the initial capacity of 10 bcm/y. The total power of the compressor stations to be installed will be around 225 MW.

The Metering and Regulating station at Megalopoli, once carried out, will give the potential to connect the Greek gas transmission system with the EastMed pipeline.
