

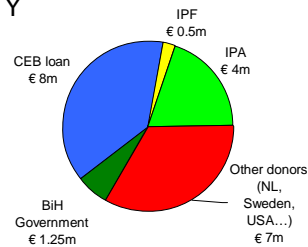
## State Prison in Bosnia & Herzegovina

### Project description

- Construction of first high security state prison, for detention of suspects / convicts of war crimes, of corruption and of economic and organised crimes
- Context of penitentiary reform; compliance with Council of Europe and EU standards; exit strategy for ICTY

### Estimated financing contributions

- Total cost: € 20.75m
- CEB contribution : € 8m loan with up to € 2m interest subsidy
- IPF, IPA, donor contributions





## Indirect Centralised Management (" Joint Management " )

### Milestones

- Joint signature in 4/2006 of MoU on co-operation in [...] the EU candidate and potential candidate countries
- CEB part of IPF Secretariat and Steering Committee, WBIF
- CEB approval in principle of participation in project (3/2008) and trust account for EU contribution (9/2008)
- Four pillar assessment under way

### Next steps

- Project update via IPF consultants by 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2009, Project Implementation Unit currently being mobilized
- Contribution agreement with Commission, trust account facility available to other potential donors, final project approval by CEB expected in June 2009
- Framework loan agreement with BiH (Ministry of Justice), parallel disbursements to begin by late 2009 / early 2010
- Government in charge of project implementation, CEB responsible for technical and financial monitoring
