- >1 tones / year
- 25.300 substances
- Very limited information requirements
- Possibility to apply annex III
- 1-10 tones

Dossier Evaluations:

- By XII.2013: 5% of dossiers evaluated (on track)
- By XII.2012: All legally required testing proposals

Substance Evaluation:

- By III.2012: First CoRAP adopted
- Currently: 91 substances considered

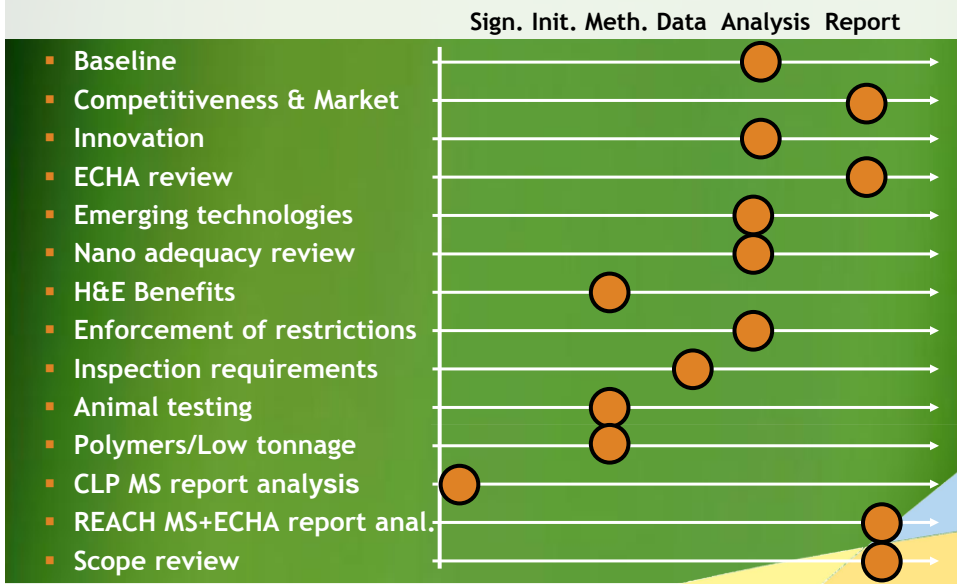
