**CLARIFICATION no. 1
to call for tender
ENV.A.3/SER/2008/0025**

Question 1: In the Curriculum, part of the above mentioned tender a five days course is foreseen, starting on a Sunday with the arrival of the participants and ending on a Friday with the departure of the participants. Taking into account that tickets for flights are significantly cheaper if a Saturday is included and having in mind the number of participants (5 times 25), we ask, if a shift of the course is possible:

- shift of the first day (arrival of participants and start of course) from Sunday to Saturday
- shift of the last day (end of course and departure of participants) from Friday to Thursday

Answer 1:

It would be possible to shift the days of the course e.g. from Sunday to Saturday and Friday to Thursday. It is obligatory though that the course shall be for 5 days - not more.

Question 2: In several expert meeting groups on Modules it was discussed that a participation in a CMI-course should be the prerequisite for participating in a Modules Training course, to ensure a similar level of knowledge. Could you please clarify, if a CMI-attendance is a prerequisite for participation in the Modules Training Course.

Answer 2:

CMI-attendance shall indeed be a prerequisite for participation in the Modules Training Course. This should be the general outline, justified exceptions should be possible.
