### SHORT SUMMARY OF CONCLUSIONS OF THE 17<sup>TH</sup> MEETING OF THE SCIENTIFIC REVIEW GROUP ON TRADE IN WILD FAUNA AND FLORA<sup>1</sup>

HELD IN BRUSSELS ON 11 JULY 2000

The SRG took the following decisions under Article 4.2.(a) of Reg. 338/97 :

**1) Positive opinions for import of specimens from the following  
species/countries combinations:**

<i>Caiman crocodylus</i>	Bolivia, Cuba (introduced population), Ecuador, Nicaragua, Peru, Trinidad & Tobago, USA (introduced population)
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NB Belize is not a range state for *Caiman crocodylus*

**2) Negative opinions for import of specimens of the following  
species/countries combinations:**

<i>Canis lupus</i> (Annex A)	Turkey (hunting trophies)
<i>Caiman crocodylus</i>	El Salvador, Guatemala, Mexico
<i>Euphyllia</i> spp	Indonesia
<i>Pterogyra</i> spp	Indonesia
<i>Hydnophora exesa</i>	Indonesia
<i>Hydnophora microconos</i>	Indonesia
<i>Chalcostigma olivaceum</i>	Peru
<i>Agapornis pullarius</i>	Mali
<i>Testudo horsfieldii</i> (source « F »/ »R »)	Uzbekistan; imports to be refused under Art. 4.2(c)/Art. 4.1(e) pending assessment of survival in captivity of « F »/ »R » specimens and conservation value of captive breeding /ranching programme
<i>Dendrobates pumilio</i> (source « R »)	Nicaragua; export permits declaring specimens to be « ranched » considered not credible and therefore invalid (Art. 4.1(b)(i))
