### SHORT SUMMARY OF CONCLUSIONS OF THE 18<sup>TH</sup> MEETING OF THE SCIENTIFIC REVIEW GROUP ON TRADE IN WILD FAUNA AND FLORA<sup>1</sup>

HELD IN BRUSSELS ON 7 NOVEMBER 2000

The SRG took the following decisions under Articles 4.1(a)(i) and 4.2.(a) of Reg. 338/97 :

**1) Positive opinions for import of specimens from the following species/countries combinations:**
