

**SHORT SUMMARY OF CONCLUSIONS OF THE 52<sup>ND</sup> MEETING OF THE SCIENTIFIC  
REVIEW GROUP ON TRADE IN WILD FAUNA AND FLORA<sup>1</sup>  
18 MAY 2010**
