

**CLARIFICATION (2)

Question:

The content/detailed description of task 1.3 a) mentions "classification of monitoring of hazardous waste". It is unclear to us what is meant by this phrasing. Does it refer to elements included in the description of task 1.2 on FAQ/guidelines on the new waste framework directive, in casu the application of article 18 on the mixing ban for hazardous waste?

Or does it refer to the question when a waste is to be considered hazardous or non-hazardous, e.g. in case of mirror entries in the List of Waste Decision?

Or does the monitoring refers to follow up systems e.g. for transfrontier shipments or for treatment in accordance with minimum treatment standards (task 1.4)?

Answer :

Apparently there is a typing error. It should say: the classification *and* monitoring of hazardous waste.

It does refer to the classification of waste as hazardous, using the H-criteria of Annex III of the Waste Framework Directive and the criteria laid down in Art 2 of the List of Waste (2000/532/EC). Monitoring means implementation of the requirements under Art 17 and 19 of the Framework Directive to ensure traceability of hazardous waste disposal and Art 18 to prevent dilution of hazardous substances in waste and under the Waste Shipment Regulation as far as hazardous waste is concerned.
