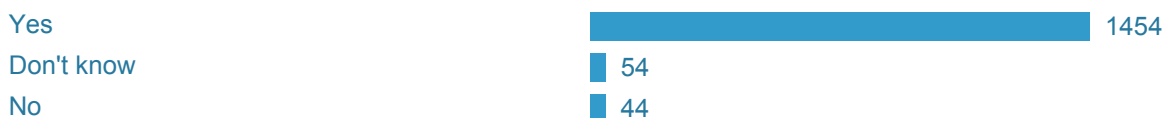


Compulsory control and standardisation of application equipment (sprayers)



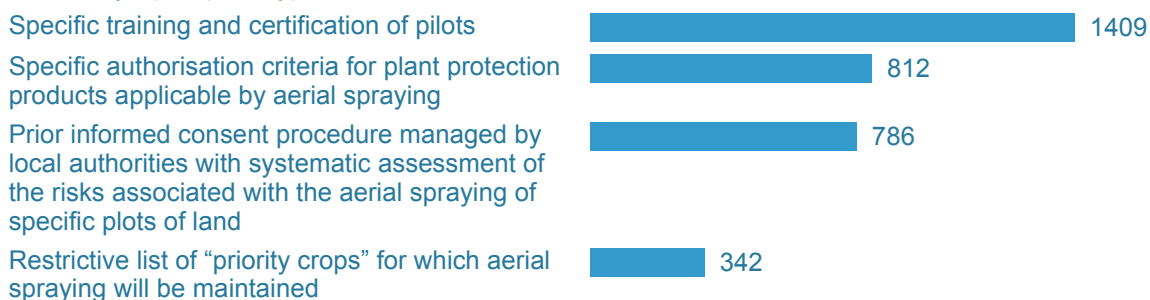

In your opinion what minimum requirements should be covered by national regulations to ensure that aerial spraying is done carefully?(compulsory)

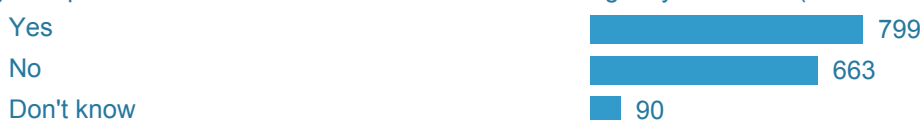


Areas of strongly reduced or zero PPP use

In your opinion do you consider that such restrictions would be required to ensure a higher level of protection for such vulnerable sections of the population or the environment?(compulsory)

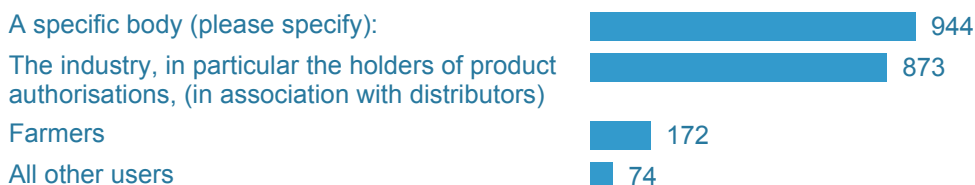


In your opinion should such restrictions be lifted in emergency situations (to be determined)?(compulsory)

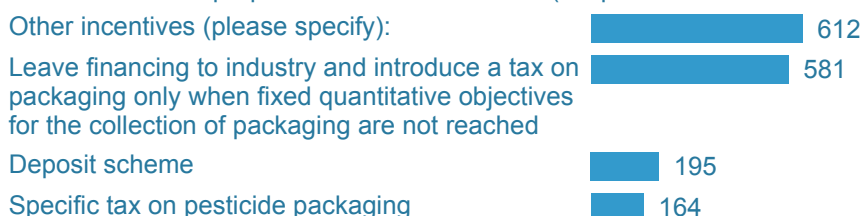


Collection of PPP packaging and unused (obsolete) products

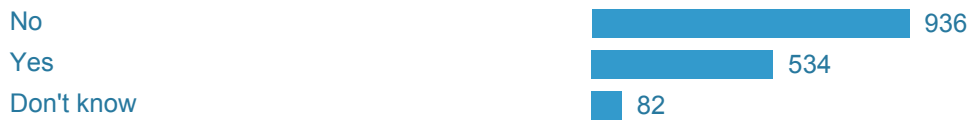
