

## **Florin Moisă**

Florin Moisă is currently the Executive President of the Resource Center for Roma Communities (RCRC) in Cluj Napoca, Romania. With a Social Work background (graduated in 1995, the first generation of Social Workers after 1990), he worked between 1995-1998 as a TA for the Social Work Department, Babeş-Bolyai University Cluj Napoca, and between 1998-1999 as a Program Coordinator for Open Society Foundation Romania. He continued during the whole period to teach part time at the Social Work Department and also at the Journalism Department, Babeş-Bolyai University Cluj Napoca.

Starting 2000 he is running the Resource Center for Roma Communities. Under Florin Moisa's leadership, RCRC developed in the last 11 years many programs for improvement of the Roma population condition, and gained an extensive expertise in the field of European Union programs - pre-accession and structural funds.

In 2006 he continued his studies and has a Master of Business Administration at Transylvania Business School, Babeş-Bolyai University Cluj Napoca and starting 2008 is PhD Student within the same university. He is also involved in consultancy activity in the field of organizational development, project management, community development, monitoring and evaluation.
