The European Commission launches a pilot project to prepare staff from Partner countries under the European Neighbourhood Policy ('ENP') for EU-ENP related jobs

The European Commission is providing € 2 million to train civil servants and personnel from ENP public administration agencies and Ministries on EU and ENP Policies over the next three to four years.

The pilot project is aimed at offering tailor-made training sessions to relevant staff in order to enhance their professional skills on the European Neighbourhood Policy as well as on other relevant EU policies.

Training will focus on the functioning of EU institutions, on the external dimension of internal EU policies as well as on the European Neighbourhood Policy and accompanying regional themes and institutional frameworks (i.e., the Euro Mediterranean Partnership, the Union for the Mediterranean and the eastern Partnership).

The pilot project targets at creating highly skilled EU-ENP contact points and consequently should help facilitating relationships between the EU and the neighbourhood countries and improving effectiveness of EU-ENP policies.
