2. Objectives of the programme, priorities for 2009 and expected results

The general objective of this call for proposal is to assist civil society organizations in becoming an effective drive for good governance reform.

The priorities of the call for proposals are:

1. Promoting public policy development through a participative civil society in the areas of democratic culture, political dialogue, women empowerment, youth , media, justice, good governance, human rights, citizenship and civic education.
2. Promoting coalition building, networking, coordination and communication among civil society organizations in developing a partnership with government.
3. Forging closer relationships between the government on both the national, and local levels with citizens, and facilitating interaction between citizens and the government at national and local levels, while increasing citizens' involvement in the overall sustainable development process.

The project specific objective is to support the criminal justice reform process in line with international standards and EU best practices. The project specific objective builds on the following inter-linked components:

2. Efficiency, Transparency and Accountability of the Judiciary
3. Independence of the Judiciary and Access to Justice
4. Penitentiary Reform

2. Objectives of the programme, priorities for 2009 and expected results

The global objective of this programme is the development of the services sector of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and its internationalisation. Services sector companies could target specific international markets, plan and determine the activities necessary to present their products at international trade fairs, congresses, symposia or exhibitions in order to increase their internationalisation capacities.

5 revolving call for proposals will be implemented under the programme

1. Development of export facilities of Jordanian Services companies
2. Support to export development for Jordanian Services companies
3. Support to joint activities, to Business Associations, to Federation for the development of export facilities , which include studies, marketing research, market analysis etc.
4. Support in the certification process (ISO, CE; etc.)
5. Services enterprises start-ups and reinforcements

3. Eligibility conditions

Registered services enterprises and in case of call 3 registered services association or federation established in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan

4. Selection and award criteria

The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the procedures set out in the Practical Guide to contract procedures for EC external actions

5. Maximum rate of Community financing

Community financing falls between 60%-80% of eligible costs, a differentiated co-financing will be applied, based on the type of cost and action. In the call 5, for particularly disadvantaged areas in the country or actions related to particular disadvantage groups or action presented by entities created by/or among women the maximum contribution may be up-to 95
