

EIDHR 2011-2013 Multiannual Indicative Planning

Global Calls for Proposals + CBSS

The EIDHR Strategy Paper 2011-2013 is mostly a continuation of the previous strategy. Compared to the previous strategy, however, it puts more emphasis on the situations where human rights are the most at risk (Objective 1) and on Country-Based Support Schemes, as different evaluations have shown that the fact that projects targeting specific issues in one country or smaller region are more likely to achieve positive impact than projects that are global in scope.

The EIDHR 2011-2013 Strategy Paper will be implemented through two global calls for proposals every year and around 90 local calls for proposals launched by EU Delegations annually or bi-annually.

Global Calls for Proposals

Global Call for Proposals 1: to be launched in the first semester of each year, targeting countries where **human rights and fundamental freedoms are most at risk and human rights defenders**. This call will receive an indicative allocation of €15,7 million in 2011, €24,7 in 2012 and €24,8 million in 2013.

Global call for proposals 2, to be launched in the first semester of each year, with following indicative allocations:

2011: €21,6 million – priorities include transnational and regional actions with a focus on peaceful management, mediation or resolution of conflicting interests or sources of deep-seated conflict or potential violent conflict (€5,9 million), reinforcement of the role of transnational civil society organisations and networks (€5,8 million), implementation of the Democracy Support Agenda for Action (€2,9 million), actions against the death penalty (€7 million).

2012: €27 million – priority will fall on actions against torture and other forms of Cruel, Inhuman and Degrading treatment or Punishment (€20 million) and Master's Degree Programmes in Human Rights and Democratisation outside the European Union (€7 million).

2013: €27 million – priority will fall on civil society actions in support of the International Criminal Court (€7 million), actions in support of the EU guidelines on children and armed conflict, promotion and protection of the rights of the child and violence against women and girls and combating all forms of discrimination against them (€10 million), and actions against torture and other forms of Cruel, Inhuman and Degrading treatment or Punishment (€10 million).
