Q: One of our clients is looking for an investor for a new business in Sector X. Is it possible that NIF can help him?

A: Please note that as indicated on our website, the NIF can only provide grants to projects submitted by Eligible Finance Institutions (you can find the list of Eligible development banks here: http://ec.europa.eu/europeaid/where/neighbourhood/regional-cooperation/irc/investment_en.htm) we would suggest you to contact these institutions before. Your client business may be eligible under one of the actions that these institutions are financing and implementing.

Q: What are the financial institutions to be contacted for projects of investment in Country X? Could you please provide their contact details?

A: You will find on the NIF website the links to all Eligible Finance Institutions. We kindly suggest you go through their Communications Office to find the more appropriate person to deal with you queries.
