December 2014 compared with November 2014

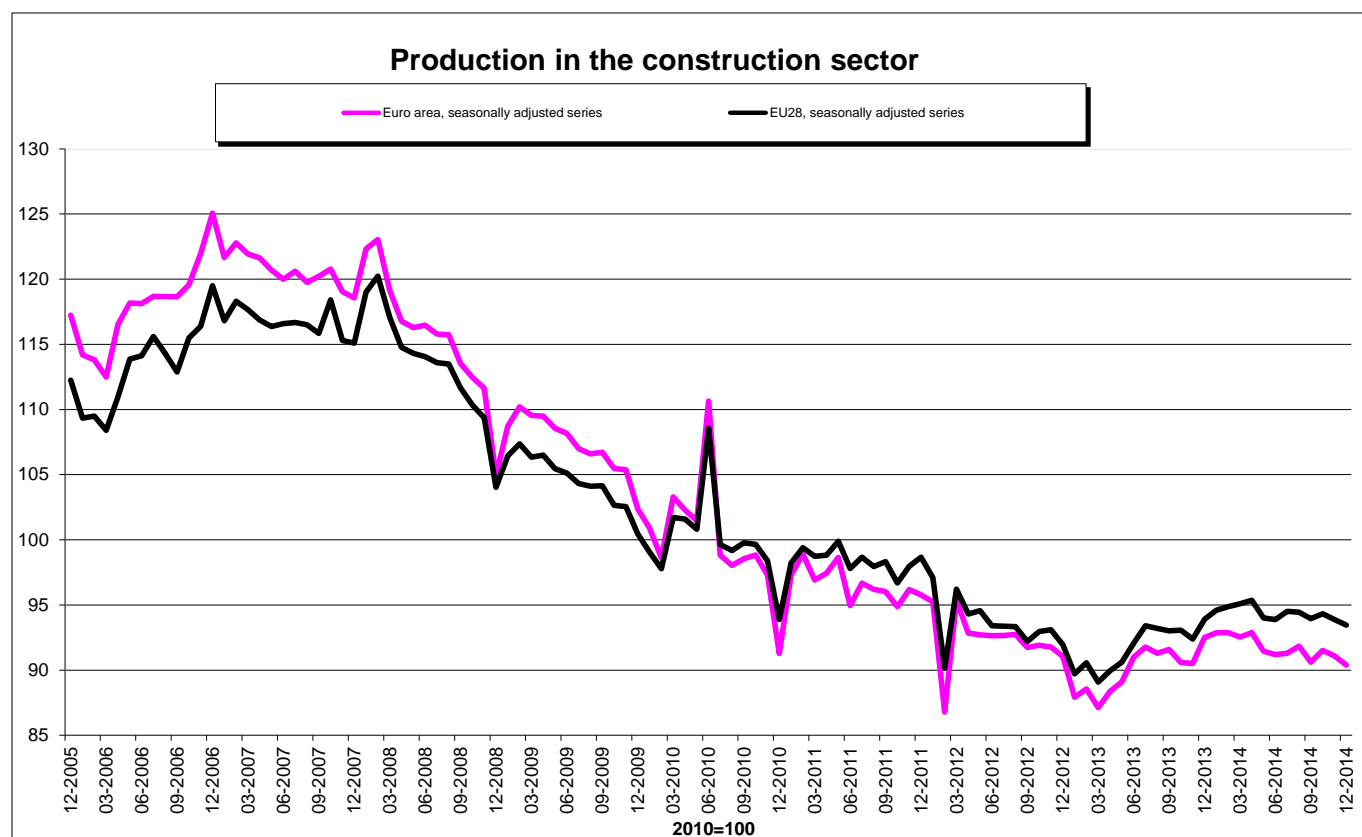
Production in construction down by 0.8% in euro area

Down by 0.5% in EU28

In December 2014 compared with November 2014, seasonally adjusted production in the construction¹ sector fell by 0.8% in the **euro area**² (EA18) and by 0.5% in the **EU28**², according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In November 2014³, production in construction fell by 0.5% in both zones.

In December 2014 compared with December 2013⁴, production in construction fell by 3.5% in the **euro area** and by 0.5% in the **EU28**.

Average production in construction for the year 2014, compared with 2013, increased by 2.0% in the **euro area** and by 3.0% in the **EU28**.



Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The decrease of 0.8% in production in construction in the **euro area** in December 2014, compared with November 2014, is due to building construction falling by 1.0%, while civil engineering grew by 1.7%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 0.5% is due to building construction falling by 0.9%, while civil engineering grew by 2.6%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest decreases in production in construction were observed in **Hungary** (-6.5%), the **Czech Republic** (-3.3%) and **Germany** (-2.9%), and the highest increases in **Romania** (+7.2%), **Italy** (+2.3%) and **Poland** (+1.0%).

Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The decrease of 3.5% in production in construction in the **euro area** in December 2014, compared with December 2013, is due to building construction falling by 4.7%, while civil engineering grew by 1.4%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 0.5% is due to building construction falling by 1.6%, while civil engineering grew by 3.8%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest decreases in production in construction were registered in **Slovakia** (-9.8%), the **Czech Republic** (-7.8%), **France** (-7.5%), **Italy** (-5.2%) and **Germany** (-4.7%), and the highest increases in **Romania** (+15.0%), **Sweden** (+9.4%), **Poland** (+4.8%), the **United Kingdom** (+4.7%) and **Slovenia** (+4.6%).

1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

2. Up to 31 December 2014, the euro area (EA18) included Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland. From 1 January 2015 the euro area (EA19) also includes Lithuania.

The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

As part of Eurostat's guidelines for the dissemination of data when the euro area is enlarged, the aggregate data series commented on in this News Release refer to the official composition of the euro area in the most recent month for which data is available. **Thus News Releases with data for months up to December 2014 comment on EA18 series, while Releases with data for January 2015 onwards will comment on EA19 series.**

3. Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 10/2015 of 19 January 2015. The monthly growth rates for November 2014 have been revised from -0.1% to -0.5% for the euro area and from -0.2% to -0.5% for the EU28. The annual growth rates have been revised from +2.2% to +0.5% for the euro area and from +2.5% to +1.3% for the EU28.
