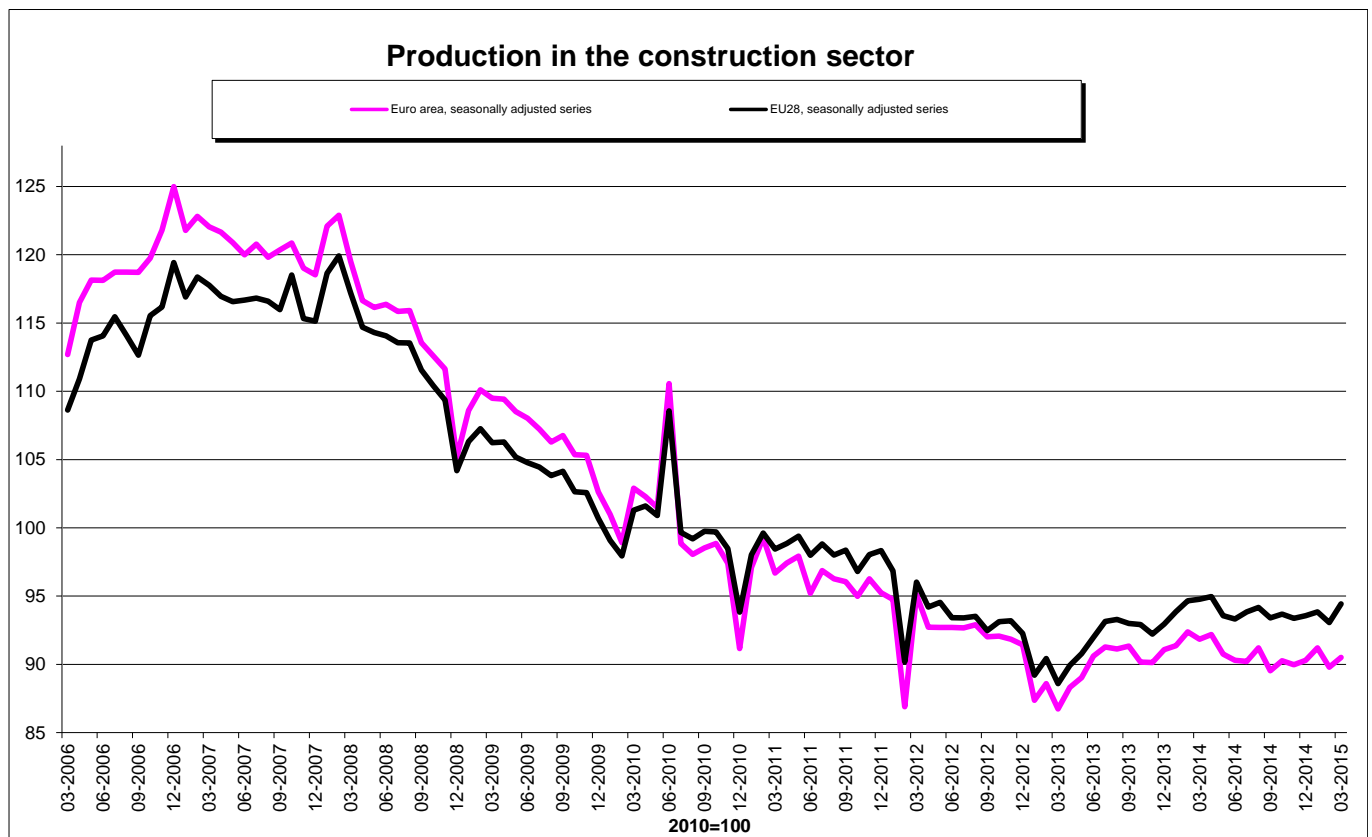


March 2015 compared with February 2015

Production in construction up by 0.8% in euro area Up by 1.5% in EU28

In March 2015 compared with February 2015, seasonally adjusted production in the construction¹ sector rose by 0.8% in the **euro area**² (EA19) and by 1.5% in the **EU28**², according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In February 2015³, production in construction dropped by 1.6% and 0.8% respectively.

In March 2015 compared with March 2014⁴, production in construction fell by 2.7% in the **euro area** and by 1.3% in the **EU28**.



Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The increase of 0.8% in production in construction in the **euro area** in March 2015, compared with February 2015, is due to building construction rising by 0.3% and civil engineering by 3.2%.

In the **EU28**, the increase of 1.5% is due to building construction rising by 1.1% and civil engineering by 3.1%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest increases in production in construction were observed in **Hungary** (+6.3%), **Romania** (+4.4%) and the **United Kingdom** (+3.8%). Decreases were recorded in **Spain** (-1.4%) and **Bulgaria** (-0.7%).

Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The decrease of 2.7% in production in construction in the **euro area** in March 2015, compared with March 2014, is due to building construction falling by 4.0%, while civil engineering rose by 2.5%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 1.3% is due to building construction falling by 2.7%, while civil engineering rose by 4.7%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest decreases in production in construction were registered in **Spain** (-8.0%), **France** (-5.3%) and **Slovenia** (-4.0%), and the highest increases in **Romania** (+13.3%), **Hungary** (+12.7%) and the **Netherlands** (+11.5%).


1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

2. The euro area (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.
The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.
The tables also include Norway and Switzerland.
3. Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 70/2015 of 20 April 2015. The monthly percentage changes for February 2015 have been revised from -1.8% to -1.6% for the euro area and from -1.2% to -0.8% for the EU28. The annual percentage changes have been revised from -3.7% to -3.5% for the euro area and from -2.4% to -2.3% for the EU28.
