



April 2015 compared with March 2015

## Production in construction up by 0.3% in euro area Down by 0.3% in EU28

In April 2015 compared with March 2015, seasonally adjusted production in the construction<sup>1</sup> sector rose by 0.3% in the **euro area<sup>2</sup>** (EA19) and fell by 0.3% in the **EU28<sup>2</sup>**, according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In March 2015<sup>3</sup>, production in construction grew by 0.6% and 1.4% respectively.

In April 2015 compared with April 2014<sup>4</sup>, production in construction remained stable in the **euro area** and grew by 1.3% in the **EU28**.



## **Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State**

The increase of 0.3% in production in construction in the **euro area** in April 2015, compared with March 2015, is due to building construction rising by 0.5%, while civil engineering fell by 1.8%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 0.3% is due to building construction falling by 0.1% and civil engineering by 2.0%.

Among Member States for which data are available, increases in production in construction were observed in **Slovakia** (+2.5%), **Spain** (+1.5%), **Germany** and **Poland** (both +1.3%) and **Sweden** (+1.2%). The highest decreases were recorded in **Romania** (-3.3%), the **United Kingdom** (-2.9%) and **Portugal** (-2.5%).

## **Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State**

Production in construction in the **euro area** in April 2015, compared with April 2014, remained stable due to building construction rising by 0.8%, while civil engineering fell by 3.2%.

In the **EU28**, the increase of 1.3% is due to building construction rising by 1.6% and civil engineering by 0.3%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest increases in production in construction were registered in **Slovakia** (+14.1%), **Romania** and **Sweden** (both +10.8%), **Hungary** (+10.7%) and the **Czech Republic** (+10.3%), and the largest decreases in **Slovenia** (-7.5%), **France** (-6.2%) and **Portugal** (-4.4%).

1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

2. The euro area (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.  
The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.  
The tables also include Norway and Switzerland.
3. Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 88/2015 of 20 May 2015. The monthly percentage changes for March 2015 have been revised from +0.8% to +0.6% for the euro area and from +1.5% to +1.4% for the EU28. The annual percentage changes have been revised from -2.7% to -1.9% for the euro area and from -1.3% to +0.1% for the EU28.
