Second quarter of 2015 compared with the first quarter of 2015 Employment up by 0.3% in euro area and 0.2% in EU28


+0.8% and +0.9% respectively compared with the second quarter of 2014

The number of persons employed increased by 0.3% in the **euro area** (EA19) and by 0.2% in the **EU28** in the second quarter of 2015 compared with the previous quarter, according to national accounts estimates published by **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In the first quarter of 2015, employment increased by 0.2% in the euro area and 0.3% in the EU28. These figures are seasonally adjusted.

Compared with the same quarter of the previous year, employment increased by 0.8% in the **euro area** and by 0.9% in the **EU28** in the second quarter of 2015 (after +0.8% and +1.0% respectively in the first quarter of 2015).


Eurostat estimates that, in the second quarter of 2015, 228.8 million men and women were employed in the **EU28**, of which 151.0 million were in the **euro area**. These figures are seasonally adjusted.

These quarterly data on employment provide a picture of labour input consistent with the output and income measure of national accounts.



Employment growth in Member States

Portugal (+1.3%) and **Greece** (+1.2%) recorded the highest increases in the second quarter of 2015 compared with the previous quarter, followed by **Ireland** and **Spain** (both +0.9%), **Estonia** (+0.8%), **Luxembourg** and **Slovakia** (both +0.7%). Decreases were recorded in **Finland** (-0.3%), the **United Kingdom** (-0.2%), **Bulgaria** and **Lithuania** (both -0.1%).

Geographical coverage

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

Methods and definitions

Employment covers employees and self-employed working in resident production units (i.e. the domestic employment concept). Unless otherwise stated, all employment estimates in this release use *persons* as the measurement unit. ESA2010 acknowledges other possible measures for employment: jobs and total hours worked.
