

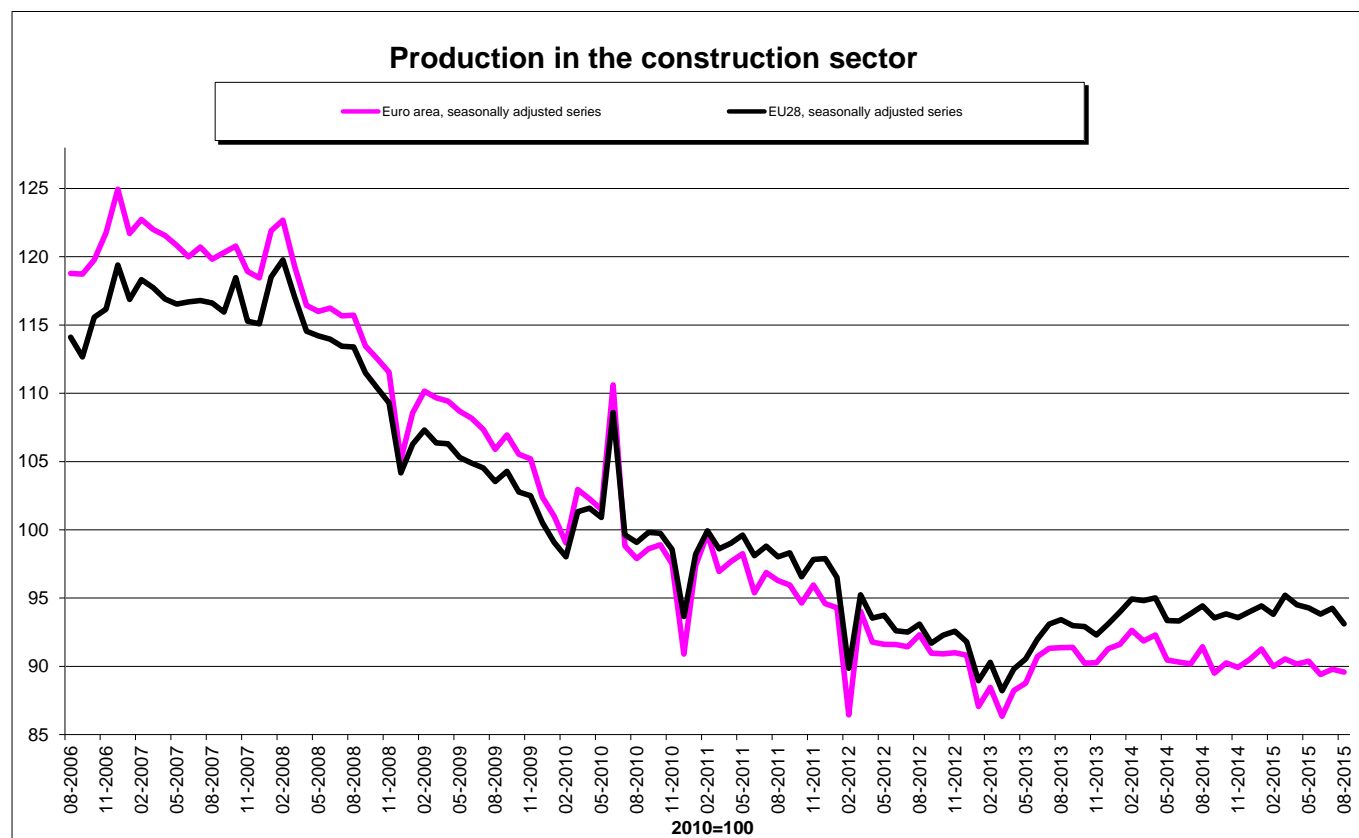
August 2015 compared with July 2015

## Production in construction down by 0.2% in euro area

Down by 1.2% in EU28

In August 2015 compared with July 2015, seasonally adjusted production in the construction sector fell by 0.2% in the **euro area** (EA19) and by 1.2% in the **EU28**, according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In July 2015, production in construction grew by 0.4% in both zones.

In August 2015 compared with August 2014, production in construction fell by 6.0% in the **euro area** and by 5.0% in the **EU28**.



## Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The decrease of 0.2% in production in construction in the **euro area** in August 2015, compared with July 2015, is due to civil engineering falling by 0.3% and building construction by 0.2%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 1.2% is due to civil engineering falling by 1.9% and building construction by 1.1%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest decreases in production in construction were recorded in **Slovakia** (-5.0%), the **United Kingdom** (-4.8%) and **Slovenia** (-4.5%), and the highest increases in **Portugal** (+0.9%), **Poland** and **France** (both +0.6%).

## Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The decrease of 6.0% in production in construction in the **euro area** in August 2015, compared with August 2014, is due to building construction falling by 6.3% and civil engineering by 5.5%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 5.0% is due to building construction falling by 6.1% and civil engineering by 0.8%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest decreases in production in construction were recorded in **Slovenia** (-15.5%), **France** (-9.2%) and **Hungary** (-6.1%), and the highest increases in **Sweden** (+13.0%), **Romania** (+10.4%) and **Slovakia** (+9.8%).

### Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Croatia, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania and Malta are not required to supply monthly data under Council Regulation 1165/98.

### Methods and definitions

The **index of production in construction** approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering.

**Seasonally adjusted** euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects.

The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

### Revisions and timetable

Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release [161/2015](#) of 17 September 2015. The monthly percentage changes for July 2015 have been revised from +1.0% to +0.4% for the euro area and from +0.7% to +0.4% for the EU28. The annual percentage changes have been revised from +1.8% to -0.3% for the euro area and from +2.3% to +0.4% for the EU28.
