**Euro area international trade in goods surplus****€19.0 bn**


€3.0 bn surplus for EU28

**Euro area**

The first estimate for **euro area** (EA19) exports of goods to the rest of the world in February 2016 was €163.5 billion, an increase of 1% compared with February 2015 (€161.4 bn). Imports from the rest of the world stood at €144.4 bn, a rise of 2% compared with February 2015 (€141.5 bn). As a result, the **euro area** recorded a €19.0 bn surplus in trade in goods with the rest of the world in February 2016, compared with +€20.0 bn in February 2015. **Intra-euro area** trade rose to €141.0 bn in February 2016, up by 3% compared with February 2015.

These data are released by **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**.

International trade in goods of the euro area, € bn



In January to February 2016, **euro area** exports of goods to the rest of the world stood at €308.5 bn, nearly stable compared with January–February 2015. Imports stood at €281.5 bn, also nearly stable compared to January–February 2015. As a result the **euro area** recorded a surplus of €27.1 bn, compared with +€27.0 bn in January–February 2015. **Intra-euro area** trade rose to €273.0 bn in January–February 2016, up by 1% compared with January–February 2015.



## European Union

The first estimate for **extra-EU28** exports of goods in February 2016 was €137.1 billion, down by 1% compared with February 2015 (€138.2 bn). Imports from the rest of the world stood at €134.1 bn, down by 2% compared with February 2015 (€136.4 bn). As a result, the **EU28** recorded a €3.0 bn surplus in trade in goods with the rest of the world in February 2016, compared with +€1.8 bn in February 2015. **Intra-EU28** trade rose to €256.7 bn in February 2016, +4% compared with February 2015.

**International trade in goods of the EU28, € bn**



In January to February 2016, **extra-EU28** exports of goods fell to €258.6 bn (a decrease of 2% compared with January-February 2015) and imports fell to €266.7 bn (-3% compared with January-February 2015). As a result, the **EU28** recorded a deficit of €8.1 bn, compared with -€10.0 bn in January-February 2015. **Intra-EU28** trade rose to €496.0 bn in January-February 2016, +2% compared with January-February 2015.

## Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.

## Methods and definitions

Since the introduction of Intrastat for intra-EU trade on 1 January 1993, the value of dispatches has been consistently higher than that of arrivals. In theory, as dispatches are declared FOB and arrivals CIF, the value of arrivals should be slightly higher than that of dispatches. Eurostat uses dispatches as the more reliable measure of total intra-EU trade as, at aggregated levels, total dispatches has better coverage than total arrivals. Due to this divergence in intra-EU trade, and to the difficulties of interpreting figures in absolute terms at the level of individual Member States, trade balances for individual Member States must be interpreted with caution. The same caution applies to the trade balance of the euro area, which includes some intra-EU trade.

National concepts may differ from the harmonised methodology used by Eurostat, leading to differences between figures in this release and those published nationally, both for raw data and for seasonally adjusted series.

Products are classified according to the Standard international trade classification (SITC), Revision 4.

## Revisions and timetable

This News Release is based on data available on 12 April 2016. These are provisional figures based on information provided by Member States. They are subject to frequent revision for up to two years after the month in question.

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## Annex - Seasonally adjusted data

In February 2016 compared with January 2016, **euro area** seasonally adjusted exports increased by 0.7% and imports increased by 2.6%. The seasonally adjusted balance was +€20.2 bn, a fall compared with January (+€22.8 bn).

In February 2016 compared with January 2016, **EU28** seasonally adjusted exports rose by 0.6% and imports rose by 0.5%. The seasonally adjusted balance was +€5.3 bn, a slight increase compared with January (+€5.1 bn).
