Dear Sirs,

I suggest that if you want to save the fish stocks, then fishing boats should be equipped to take fertilized fish eggs and infant fish on their out bound journeys to repopulate the areas where they are fishing, massive fish farms need to be setup to allow the fishing fleet to replace the fish they take out of the ocean.

Even in harsh times when no fishing is allowed, fishing boats can be paid to populate the fishing areas with infant fish for the next season, this will allow them to create a sustainable fish stock.

The fishermen can also be paid to manage their own fish farms to produce their infant fish.

Fish DNA can be taken for each farm generation and monitored by the catches to see how effective it is to determine where the different types of fish population spread into the EU fish markets.
