I believe that where scientific advice is paid for and obtained with public money with regard to TAC quotas, EU ministers should be bound by the recommendations made by those scientists. So where, for example, in 2007, scientists from the International Council for the Exploration of the Sea recommended an annual catch of 15,000 tonnes of blue fin tuna, and EU ministers ignored this and allowed a TAC quota of 29,000 tonnes, under the new regime, the EU ministers' powers would be capped at 15,000 tonnes.
