





### Seasonal flu






Kills thousands of Europeans each winter



### **Estimated Population Immunized** (Percentage) n = 18



### H5N1 "bird flu"






- 20 human cases (9 deaths) in WHO European Region



# Influenza Pandemics in 20<sup>th</sup> Century











1918: "Spanish Flu"

20-40 million deaths A(H1N1)

1957: "Asian Flu"

1-4 million deaths A(H2N2)

1968: "Hong Kong Flu" 1-4 million deaths A(H3N2)


# But there are still gaps in knowledge and preparedness....
