Actions for the Competent Authorities

- ◆ Issue transporters' authorisations for journeys and long journeys (new requirement)
- ◆ Register authorisations of journeys and long journeys (old/new req.)
- ◆ For long journeys transporters' authorisations register in an electronic database publicly available (new req.)

Actions for the Competent Authorities

- ◆ Train their staff to check the data recorded by the digital tachograph and the satellite navigation system (new req.)
- ◆ Facilitate training courses for personnel of transporters and assembly centres to enable drivers and attendants to receive a certificate of competence (new req.)

Actions for the Competent Authorities

- ◆ Inspection of means of transport by road for long journeys (old req.)
- ◆ Draw up certificates of approval for these means of transport (new req.)
- ◆ Register these certificates in an electronic database accessible to all other Member States (new req.)

Actions for the Competent Authorities

- ◆ More detailed inspection of livestock vessels (new req.)
- ◆ Draw up certificate of approval for livestock vessels (new req.)
- ◆ Record the certificate of approval in an electronic database (new req.)
- ◆ Inspect livestock vessel before and during loading, at unloading, fitness of animals to be transported, feed and water arrangements (new req.)

Actions for the Competent Authorities

- ◆ Checks at exit points and border inspection points with more detailed requirements:
 - Copy of the transport authorisation (old req.)
 - Valid certificate of competence (new req.)
 - Animals fit to continue their journey (new/old req.)
 - Means of transport does comply with the regulation (old req.)
 - Paperwork in journey log is correct (new/old req.)
