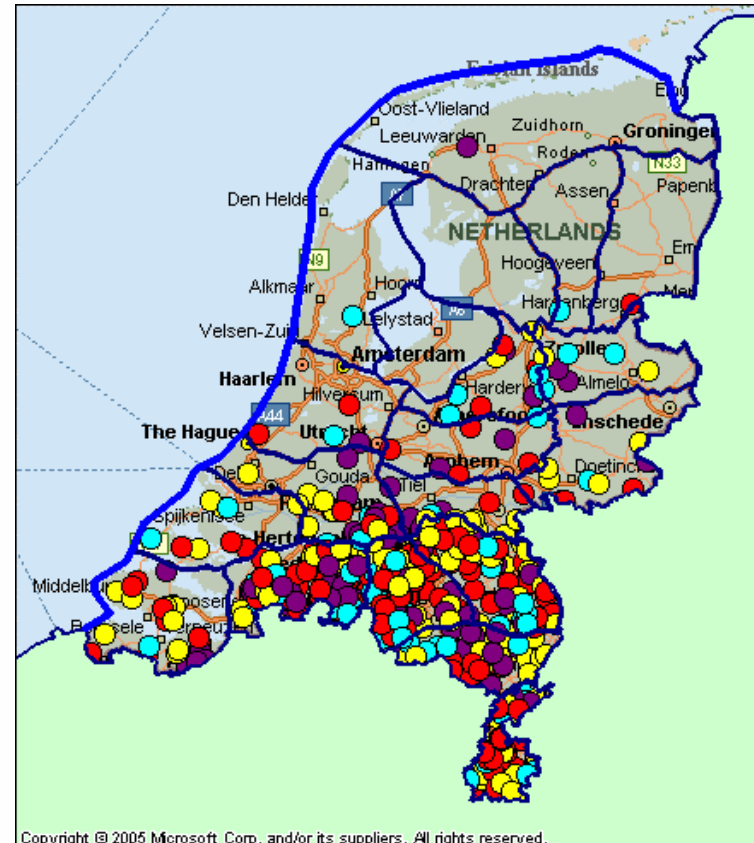

Infected area

- 378 infected holdings in the southern part of the Netherlands
- 1 infected holding in the north of the Netherlands
- As of 22 August:
the Netherlands 20 km zone



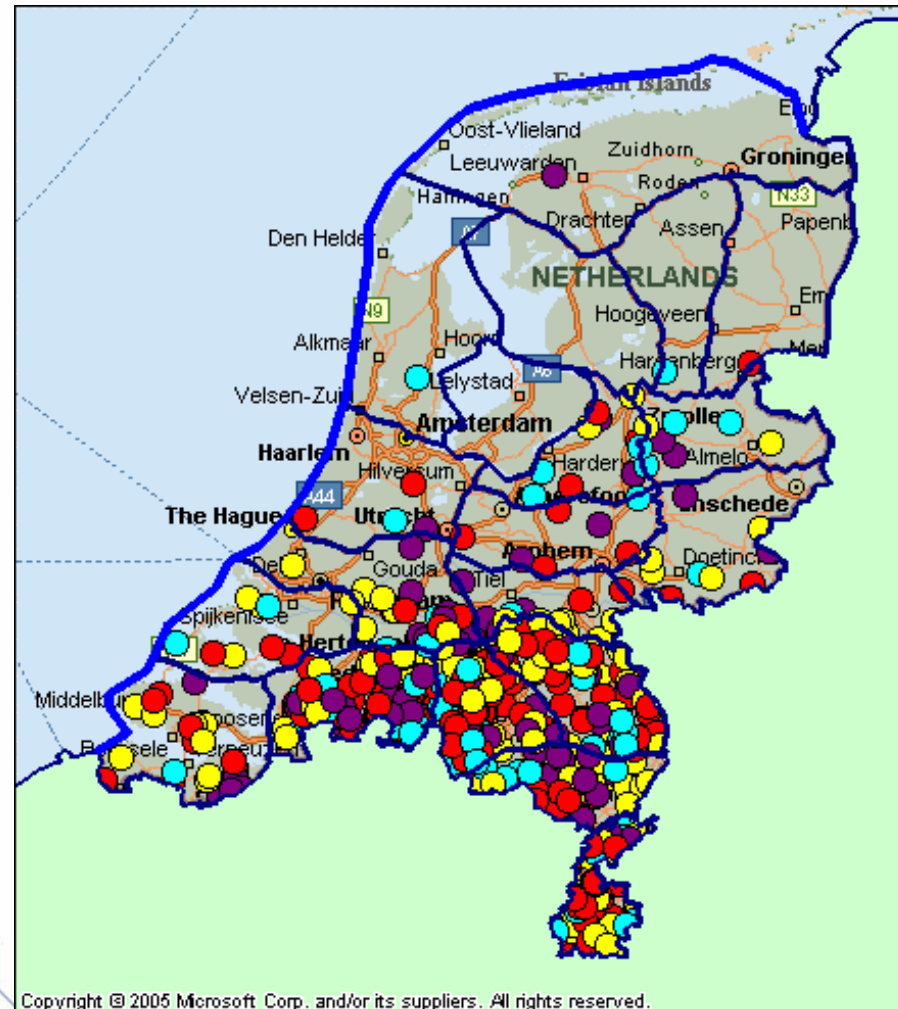
Infected holdings

379 infected holdings

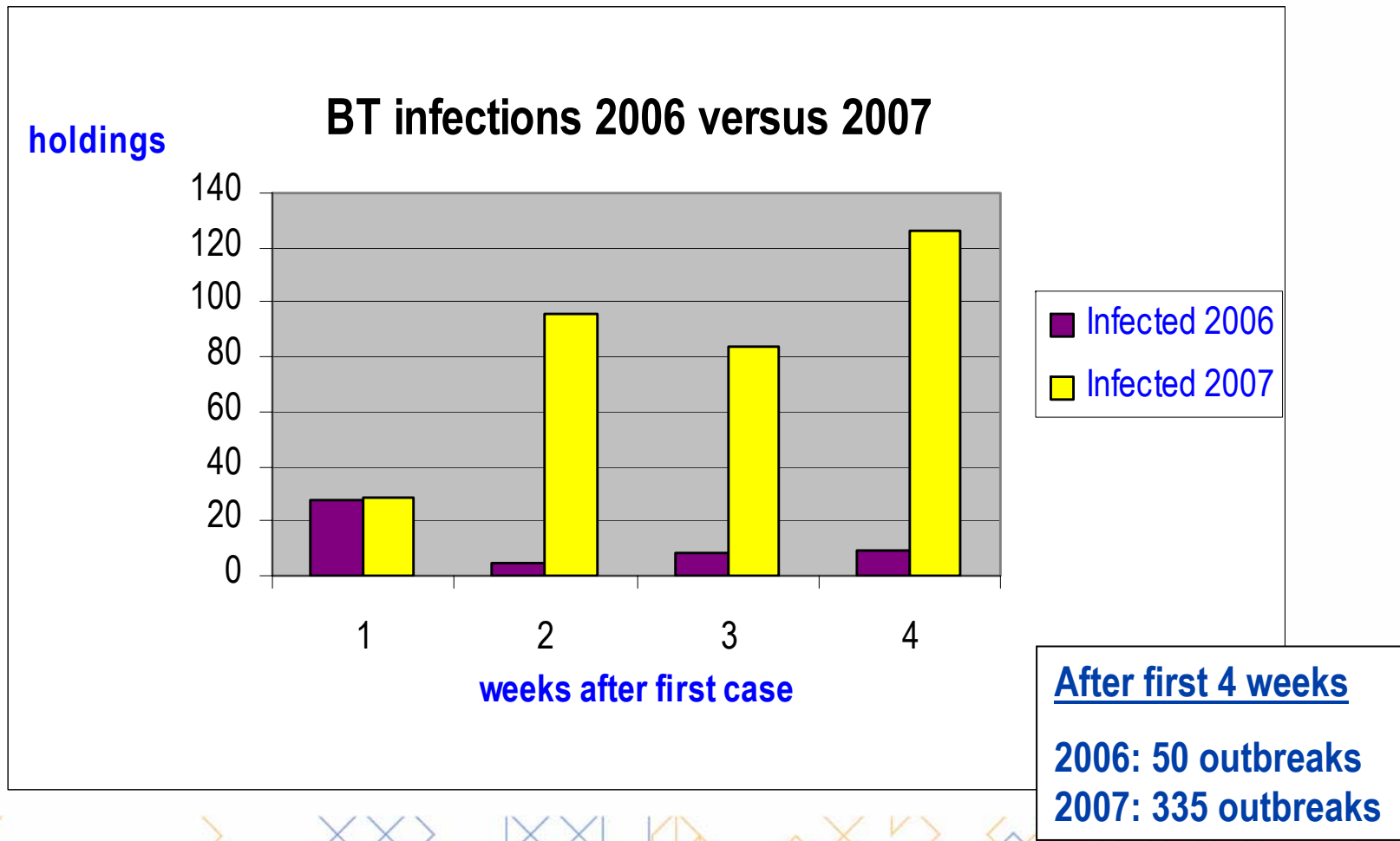
- 134 cattle holdings
- 254 sheep holdings

200 suspected cases

- 64 cattle
 - 136 sheep
- Mostly clinical



Outbreaks





Compared to 2006:

- **Start of outbreak in multiple areas in south of the Netherlands**
- **Faster spread of the disease**
- **More cases**
- **More culicoides in traps (approx. 10x)**

!! Clinical signs more severe (especially cattle)

- **More deaths**
