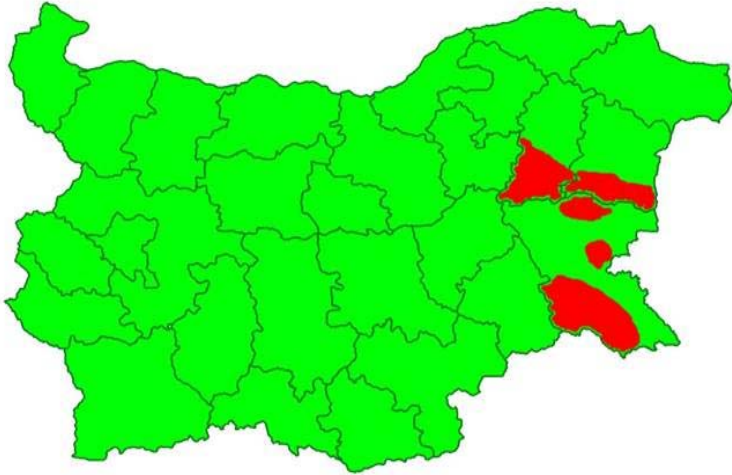

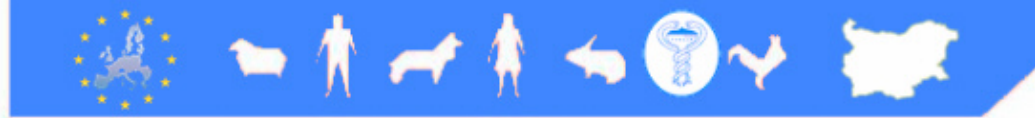

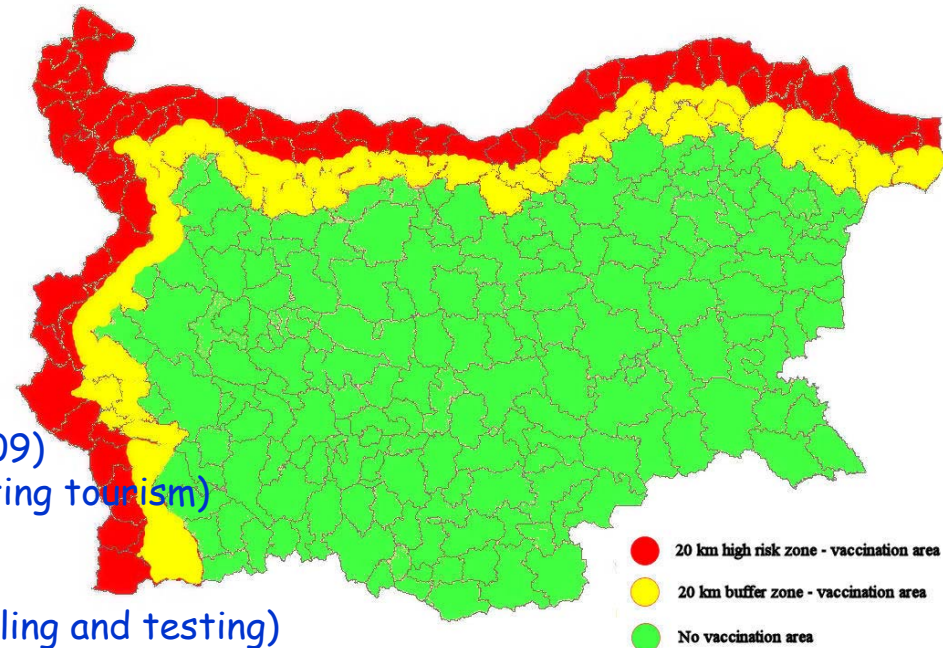

Control in wild boar



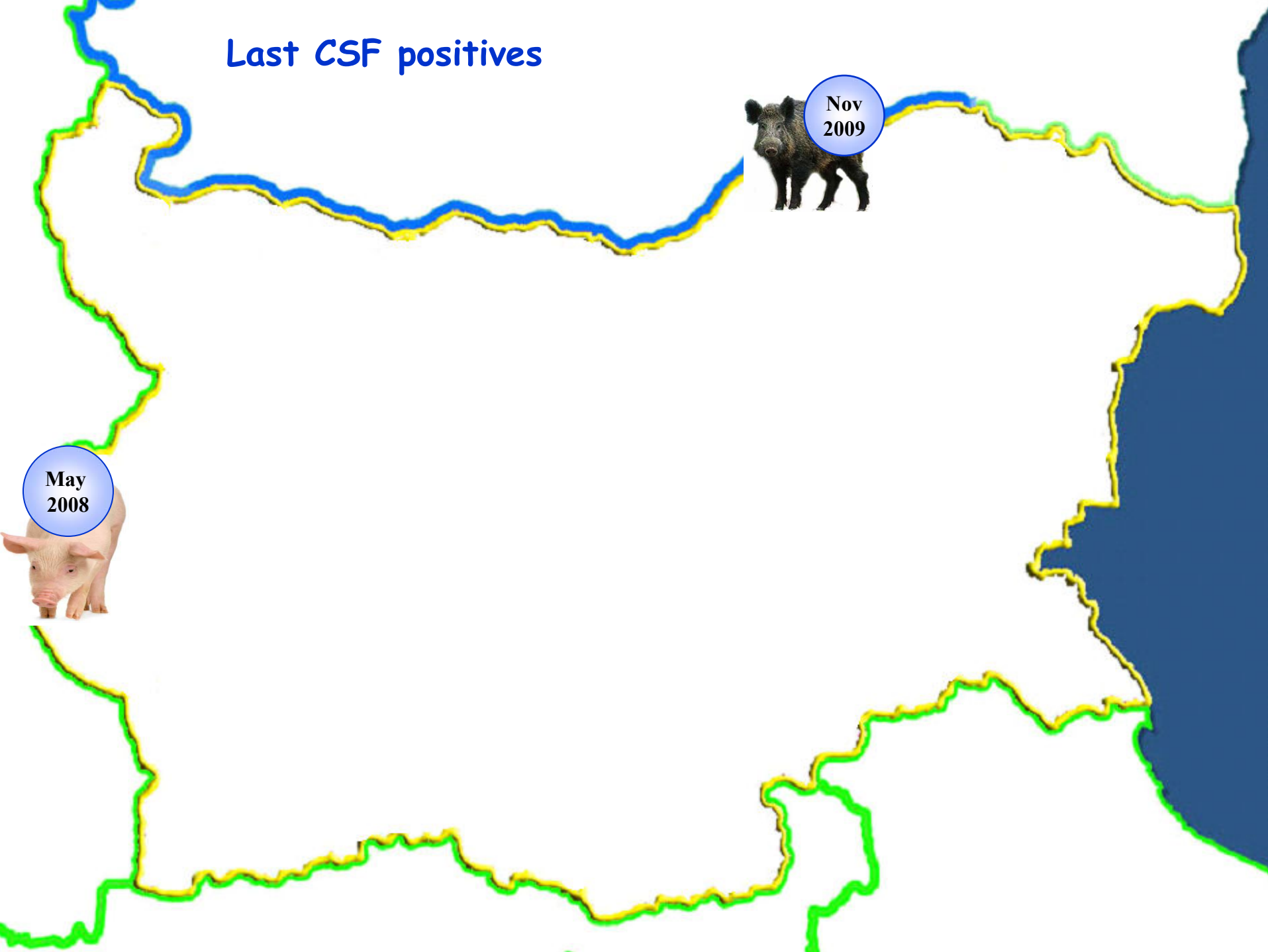
3 vaccination campaigns planned for 2010

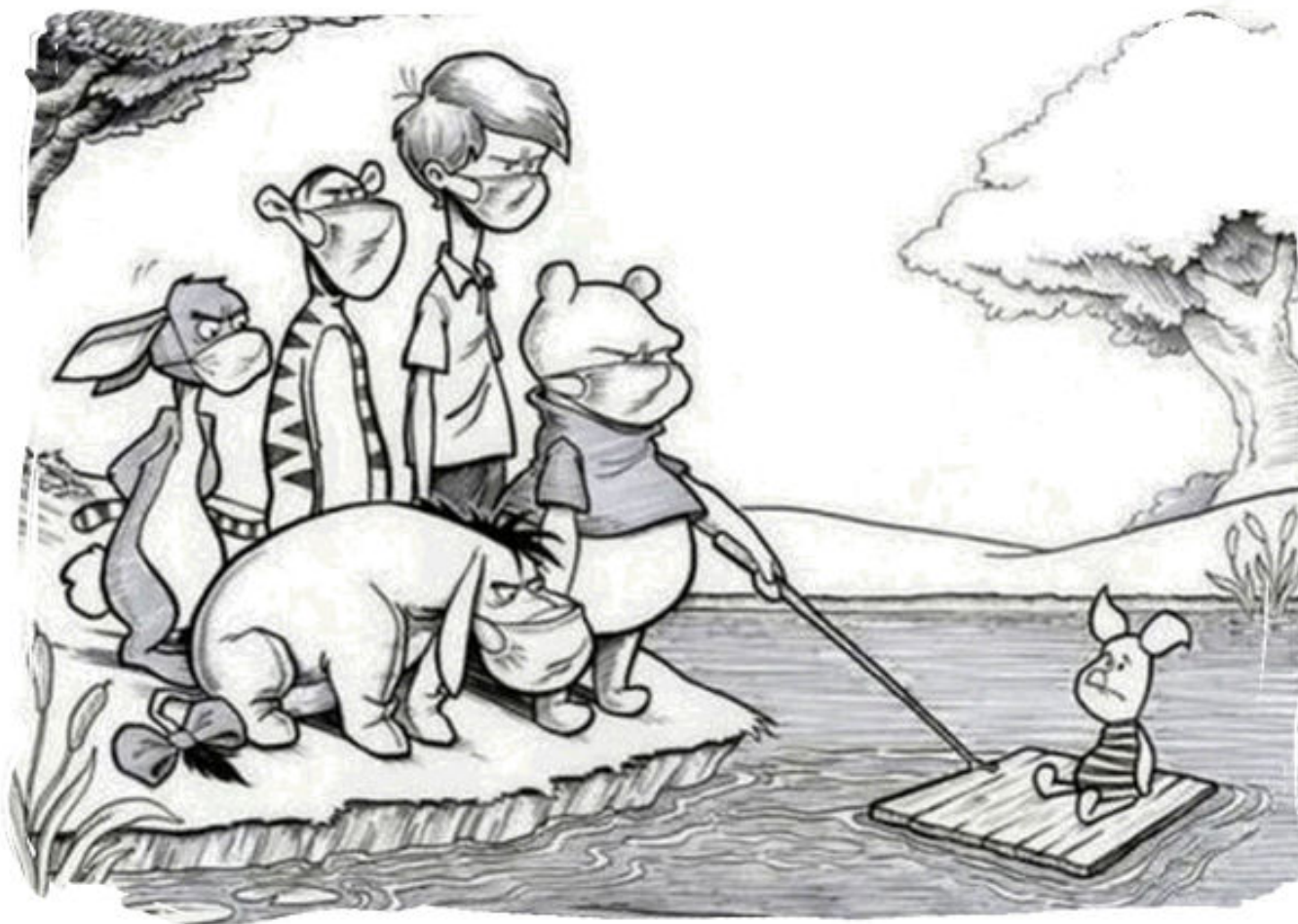
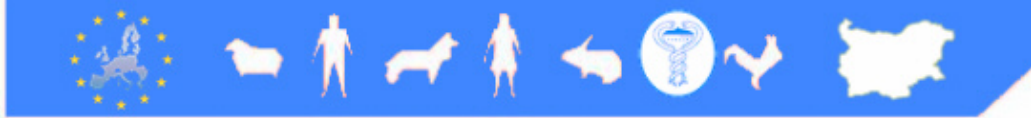
