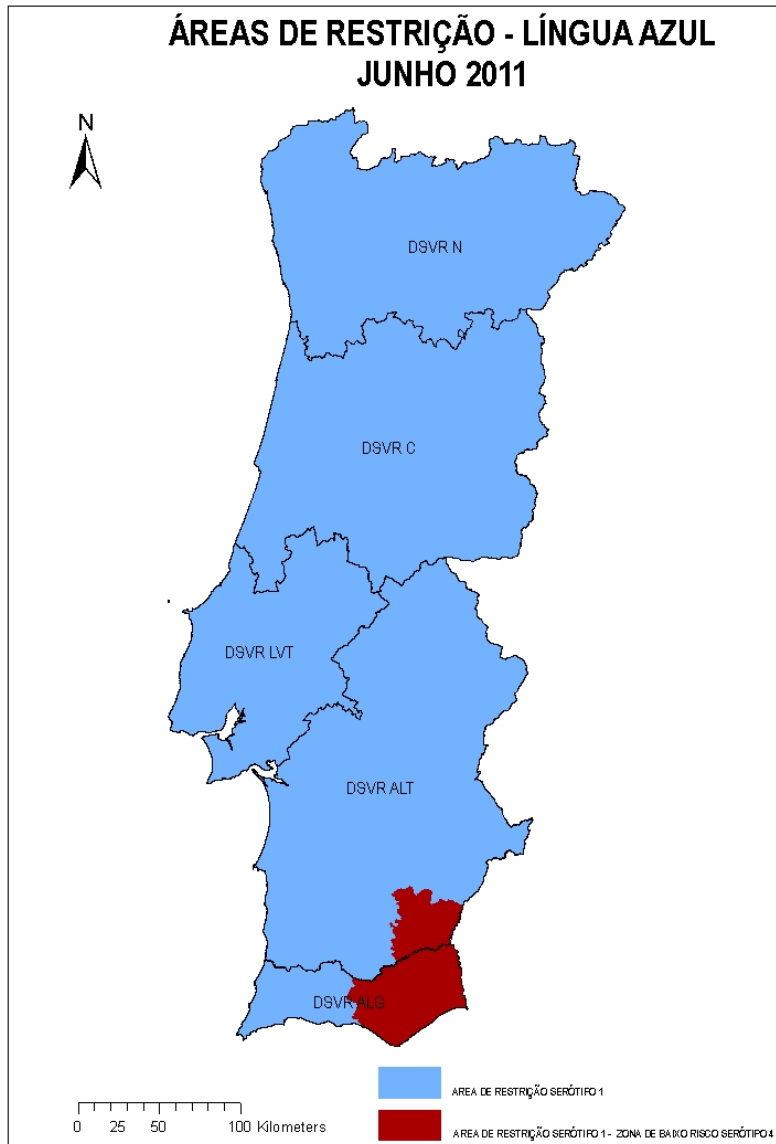

Low risk of BTV8 national incursion
Lower risk in affected countries

End of seasonally free period

Maintains:

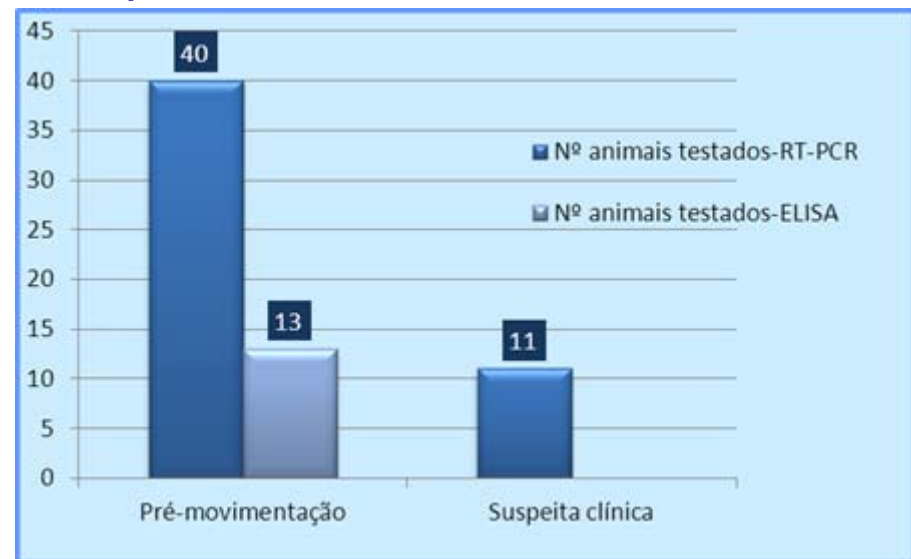
- BTV1 vaccination in mainland
- BTV4 vaccination in lower risk area

1638 samples tested in slaughterhouses
for Pan PCR (BTV1, BTV4 & BTV8)



Results of surveillance programme:
64 samples tested – pre-movement and clinical
suspicions
