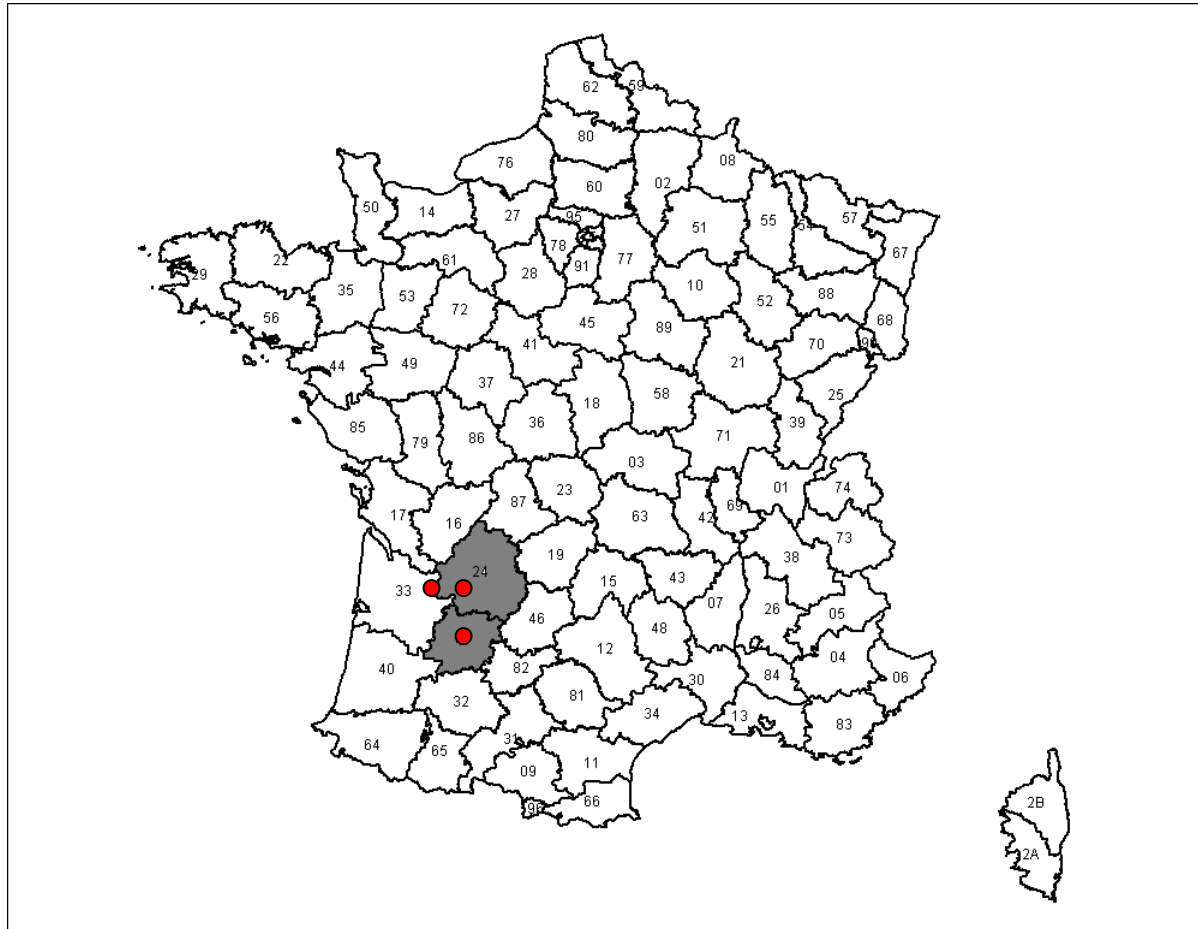
# Update - 2010

- 5 outbreaks :
  - 2 closed
  - 3 still under control measures
- Confirmed within two different frameworks :
  - 3 outbreaks in the SW: linked
  - 2 outbreaks : due to introduction of live equidae from Romania – current testing of equidae originated from Romania
- All infected horses : no clinical signs

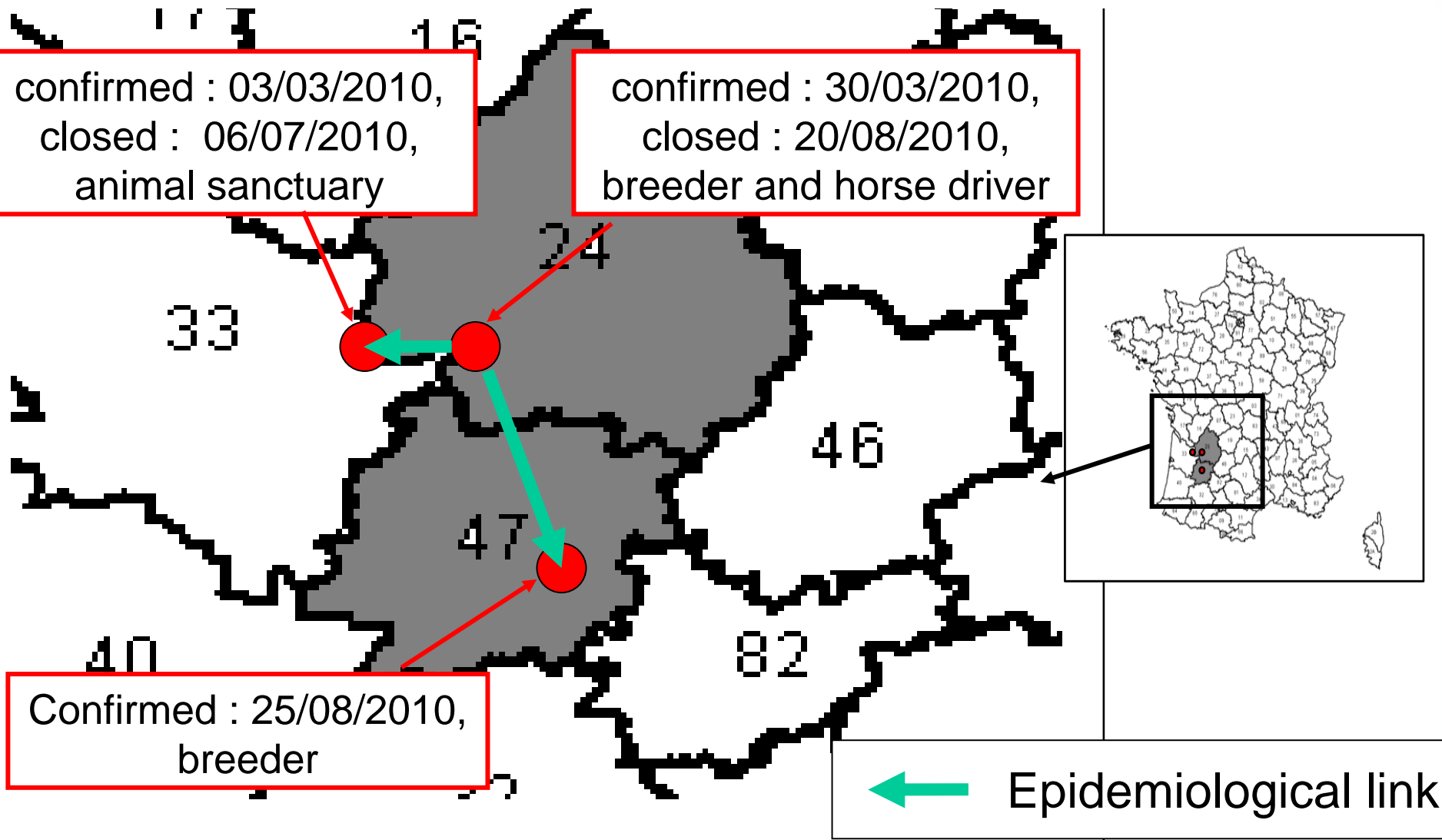

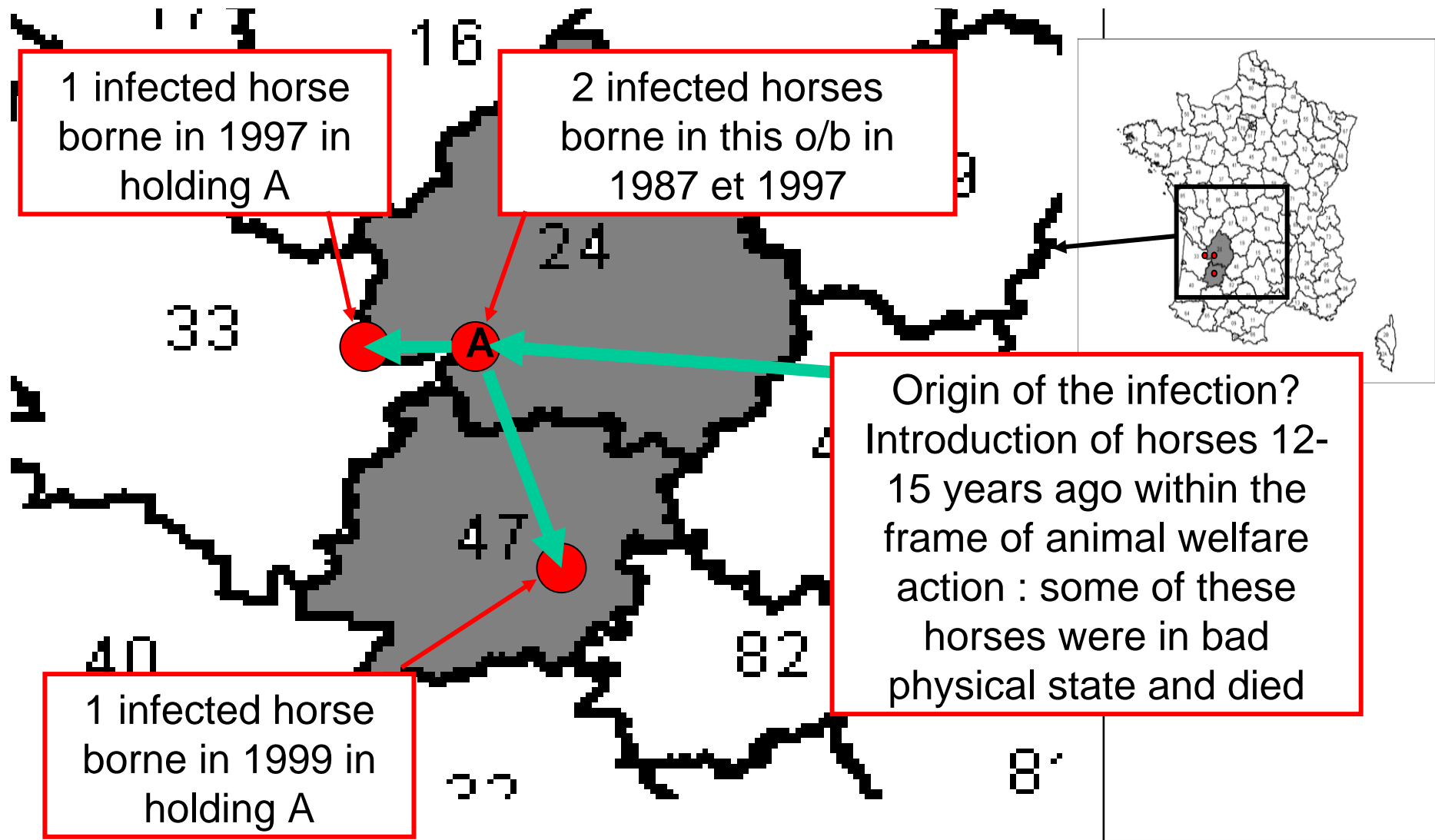
- 2 o/b in département Dordogne
- 1 o/b in département Lot et Garonne



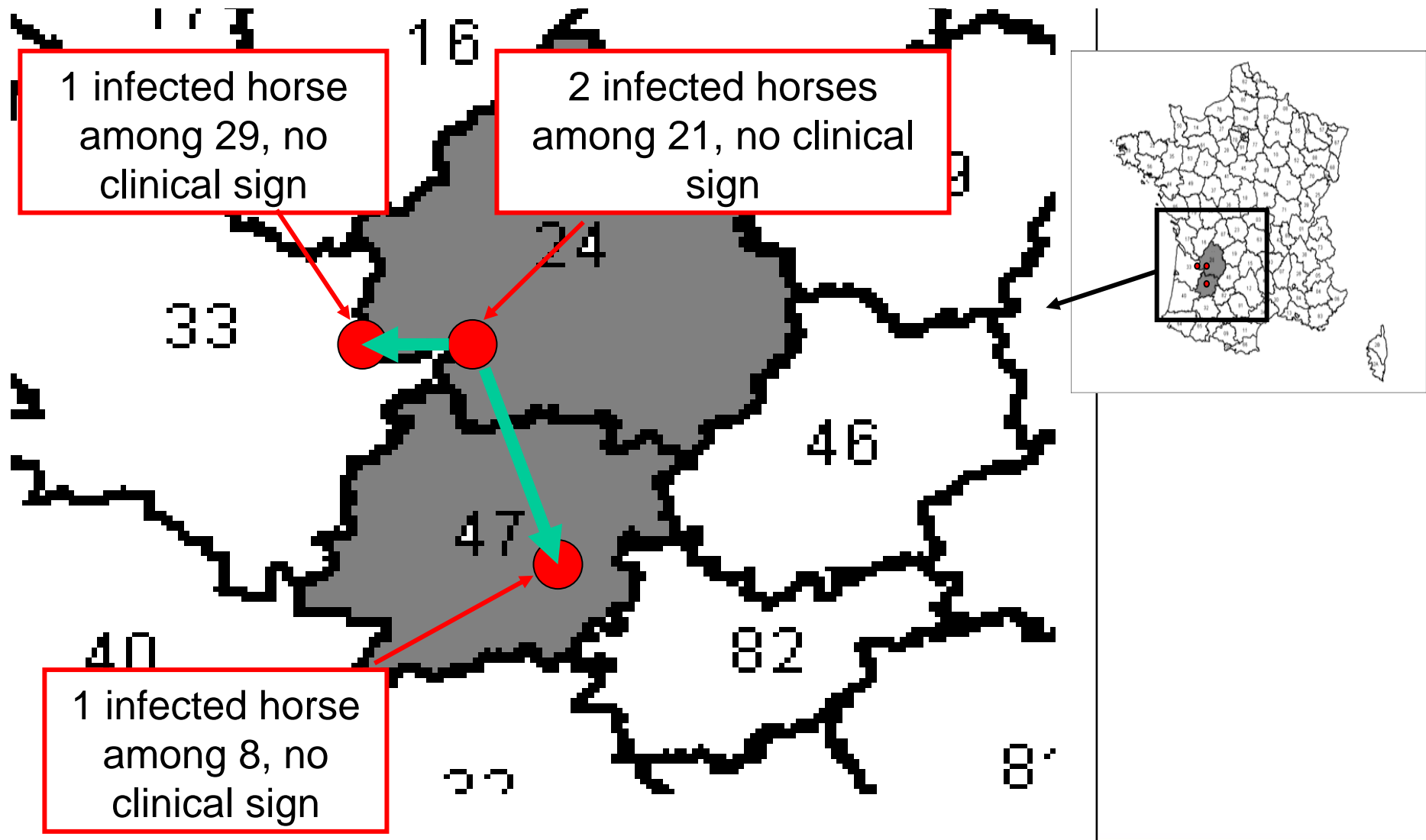

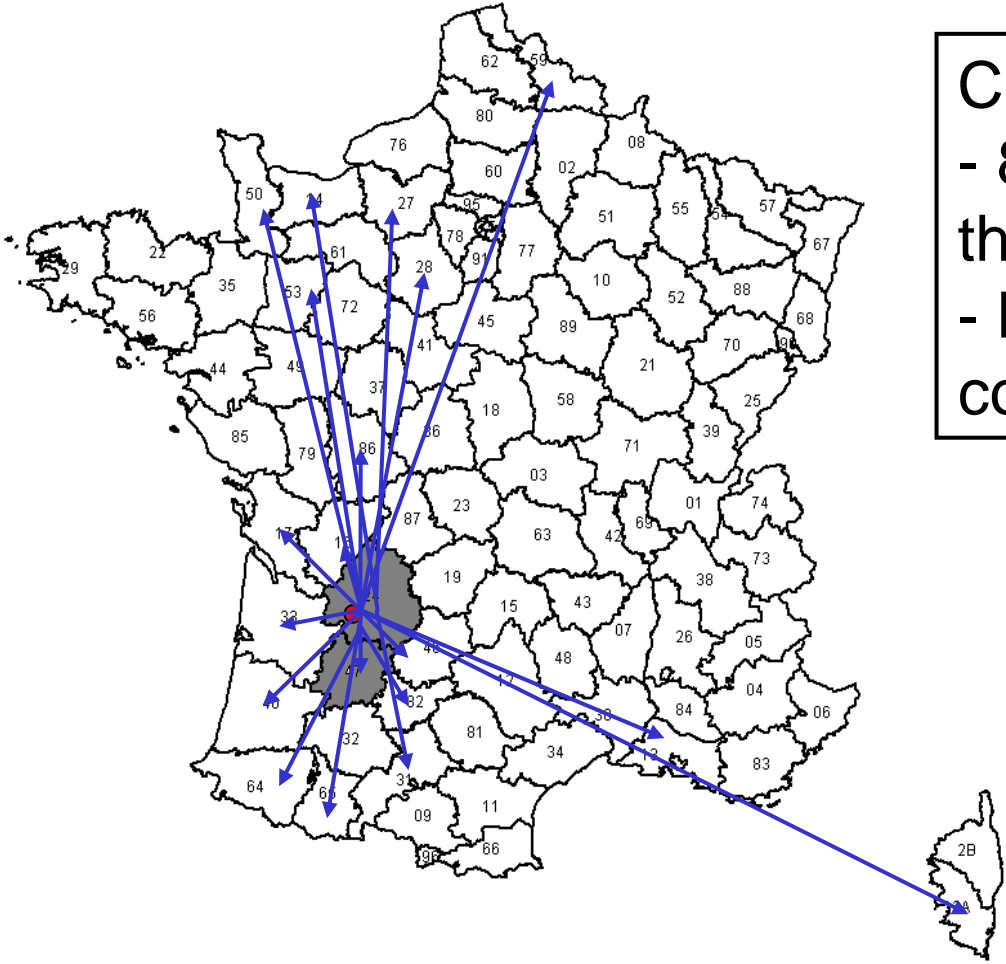

Current investigations :

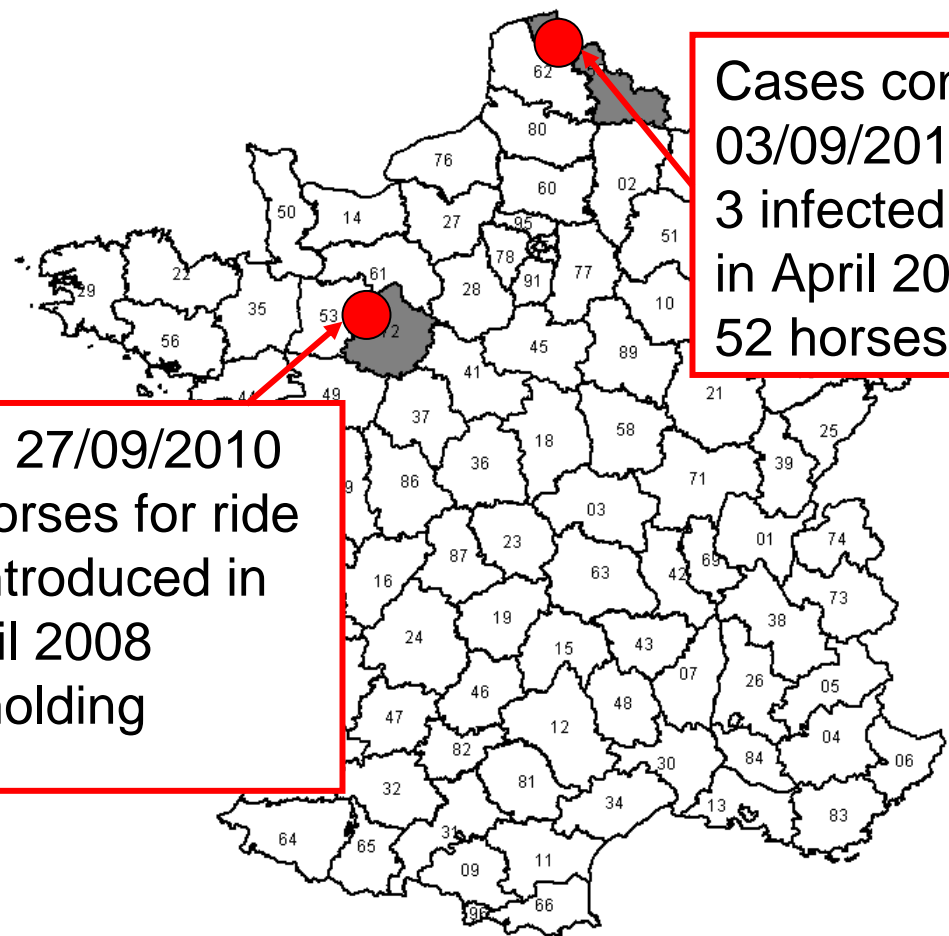
- 87 horses which stayed in the holding A since 1990;
- Many départements concerned



# Equidae originated from Romania

- Current investigation : testing of equidae originating from Romania and which have been introduced in France since 2007
- 34 horses introduced directly in France
- 47 horses introduced in France through Belgium
- Horses currently traced and tested

# Equidae originated from Romania



Cases confirmed :  
03/09/2010 horse milk farm  
3 infected mares introduced  
in April 2008  
52 horses in the farm

-Case confirmed : 27/09/2010  
holding renting horses for ride  
1 infected mare introduced in  
the holding in April 2008  
38 horses in the holding

in 2008, 2009, 2010

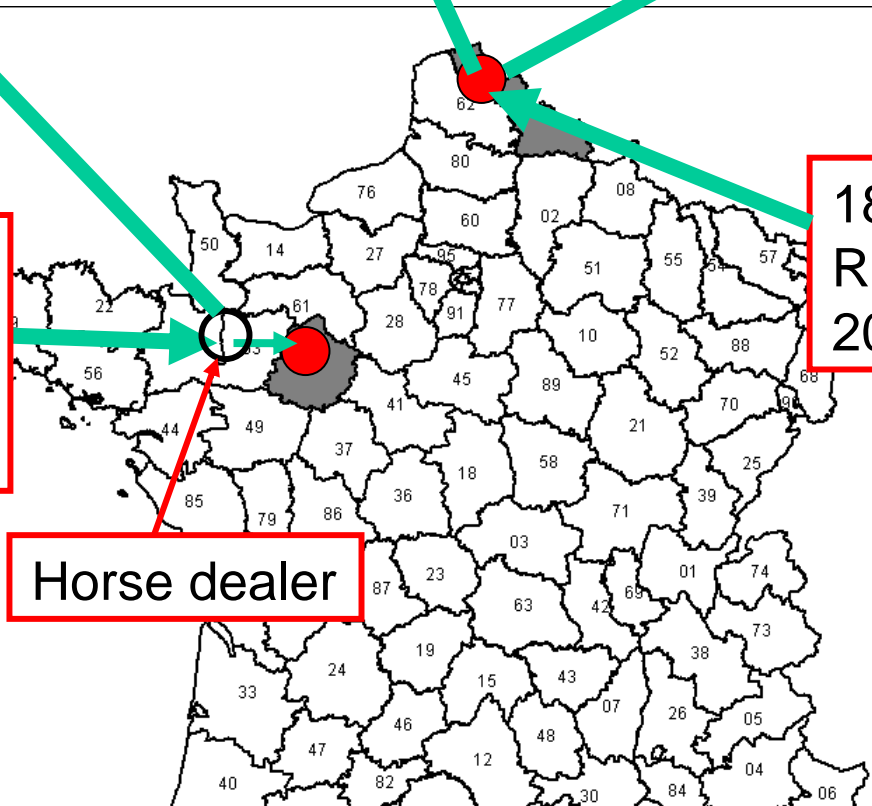
