# EIA SITUATION 10.04.2010

- All the positive horses is only from house holdings
- No positive cases from competitions horses, pure breeds establishments, studs, hippodromes, equine associations



# National movements Order 37/2010

- The sanitary veterinary health certificate shall be issued by the authorized free practice veterinarian, only for the equines which are identified with microchip having passport and which make the object of internal trade.
- The equine movement on the territory of Romania must be accompanied by sanitary veterinary health certificate in conformity with the Annex C to the Directive 90/426/EEC and passport.
- it comes/they come from a holding in which cases of E.I.A were not diagnosed during the last three months; in case the infectious anaemia was diagnosed and positive animals were disposed of, the animals which remained in the holding, can leave the holding after having obtained negative results at two Coggins tests carried out within a three months' interval;



# Intra-community trade Order 37/2010

- The equines intended for intra-community trade are dispatched only from sanitary veterinary authorized collection centers/holdings of origin and must comply with the following conditions:
- a) the animals comply with the conditions provided in the Directive 90/426/EEC on animal health conditions which establish the movement and import of equines originated from third countries;



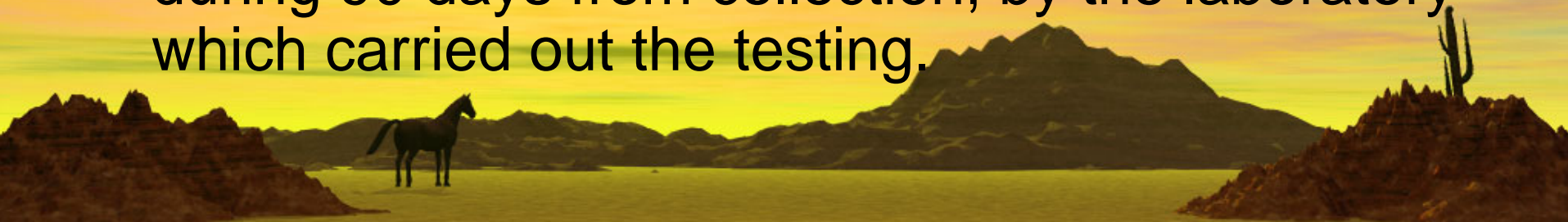
# Intra-community trade Order 37/2010

- b) they were subject to two Coggins tests for the detection of E.I.A, and their results were negative, and which were carried out on blood samples taken within thirty days before departure, and one of the tests was carried out after having entered the collection center; the respective tests with the results are indicated in section VII from the passport, provided in the Regulation (EC) no. 504/2008 on the application of the Directives 90/426/EEC and 90/427/EEC of the Council regarding the equines identification methods, which accompanies the animal during the movement;
- b) the animals are accompanied by an animal health certificate, in conformity with the Annex C to the Directive 90/426/EEC;



# Intra-community trade Order 37/2010

- The blood samples from the equines intended for intra-community trade in view of testing for E. I.A shall be sampled by the official veterinarian.
- It is forbidden the access of equines without microchip, passport and health certificate in the collection centers authorized for intra-community trade.
- The blood samples originated from equines intended for intra-community trade shall be kept during 90 days from collection, by the laboratory which carried out the testing.



# The equines intended for international competitions Orders 2 and 38/2010

- For the equines which participate in international competitions, the testing is carried out within 30 days before departure, by immunodiffusion.



# Surveillance program Orders 2 and 38/2010

- The serological surveillance of equines aged over 6 months
- a) stallions used in temporary copulation stations, when authorizing and than three times per year as it follows:
  - (i) with 15 days before leaving the storehouse;
  - (ii) with 15 days before withdrawing from copulation stations;
  - (iii) with 15 days from after return to the storehouse;



# Surveillance program Orders 2 and 38/2010

- b) the stallions from the permanent copulation stations when authorizing and twice per year respectively February-March and October-November;
- c) breeding mares, once per year ;
- d) the equidae from the holdings, studs, hippodromes, equine associations and other specialized establishments, twice per year, respectively February-March and October-November;
- e) The serological surveillance of all equidaees aged over 6 months from householdings is tested once per year.



# Surveillance program Orders 2 and 38/2010

- The passports of animals are filled in adequately in Section VII and Section VIII.



# Eradication program Order 686/2003;2 and 38/2010

- The animals positively diagnosed are slaughtered in maximum 10 days from issuing the analysis bulletin.
- Since 07.04.2010 all counties with less than 500 horses with EIA will remove animals until 30.04.2010
- Last counties will eliminate all horses with EIA by the end of 2010
