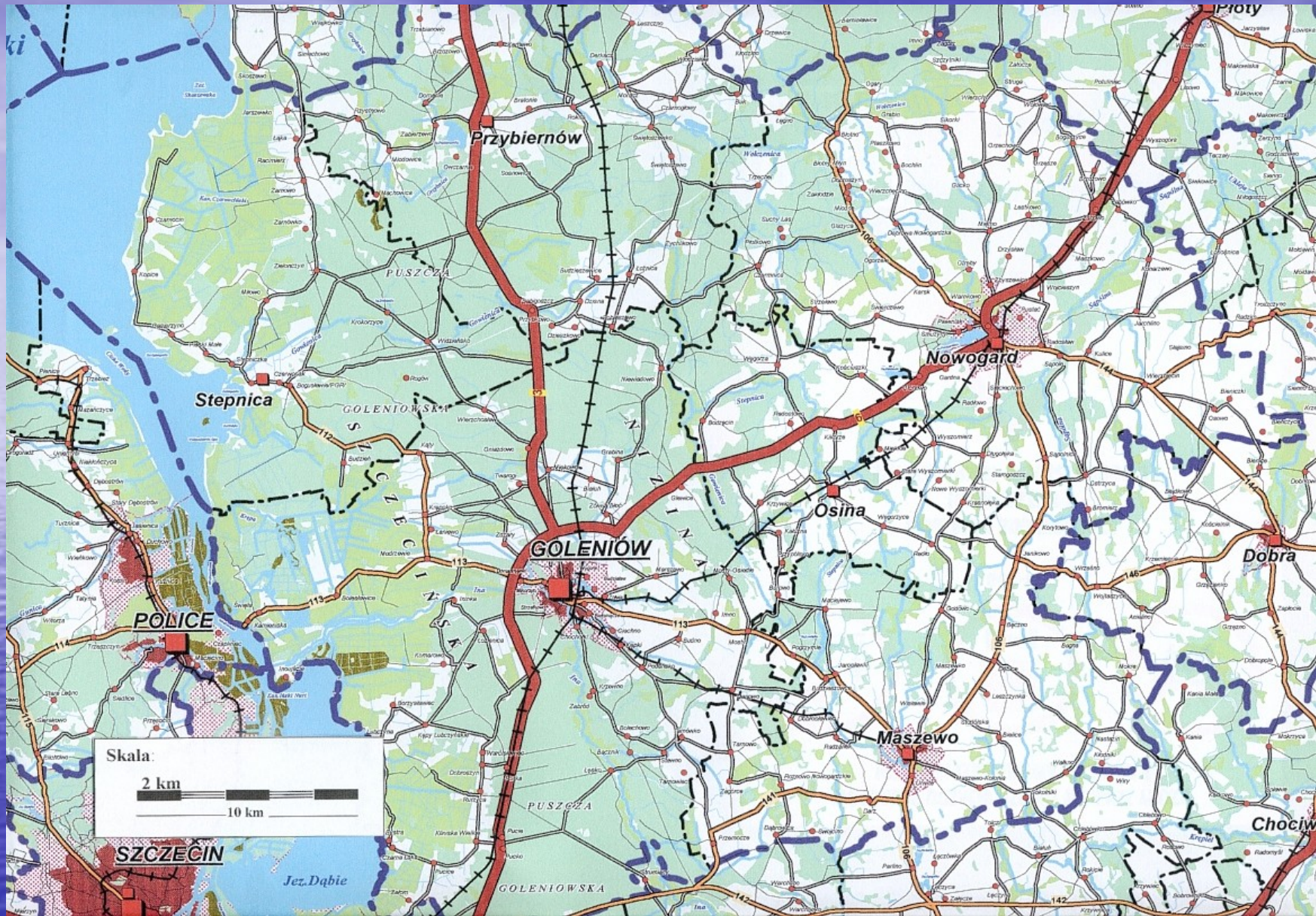
Positive test result for LPAI subtype H5 obtained in the National Reference Laboratory in Pulawy from the samples taken from turkeys (RT-PCR method).

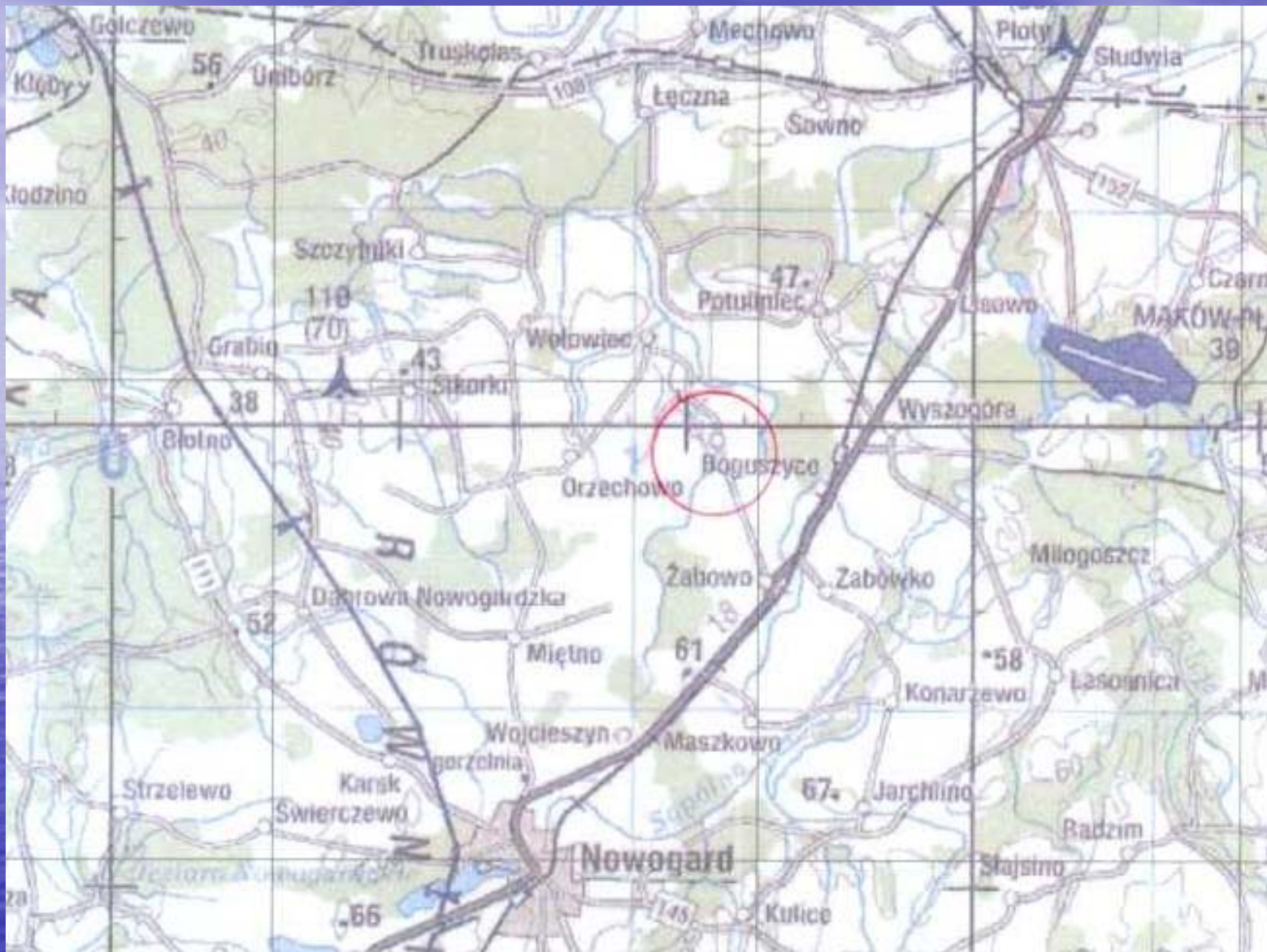
On 02.01.2009 - Restricted zone was established around the outbreak detected in turkey holding in Boguszyce (radius 1 km)

The necessary measures in accordance with Council Directive 2005/94/EC were implemented.

- **On 4.01.2009 19335 animals were killed and carcasses have been safely disposed off.**







On 5.01. 2009 - 20 blood samples and 20 corpses have been sent to National Veterinary Institute in Pulawy. Laboratory investigations are ongoing.
