Notification process :	The CAB has to apply for a designation and notification according to the Ordinance on accreditation and designation (OAccD) with the designating authority. It shall indicate the desired scope, i.e. modules, articles, products and document a corresponding active accreditation. Designation in this sector may only occur based on an accreditation by the Swiss accreditation body (SAS), a full member of European Accreditation. The designation procedure is set out in article 28 OAccD. The designating authority verifies the fulfillment of all requirements. The designating authority informs SECO of the designation; SECO notifies the CAB to the EU as required by the Agreement on the mutual recognition of conformity assessments between Switzerland and the EU.
