Engagement – underwriting the Partnership and its criteria

Inclusiveness and Partnership - widely involving all relevant actors and constituencies working together

Critical mass – sufficient, concrete and measurable resources to carry out the actions: financial and human resources, know-how and in-kind, availability/access to infrastructure, materials and research results

-> concrete and significant coverage e.g. 10% of target population

Delivery – timely delivery of agreed outcomes, against specific “deliverables” as referred in the SIP
