Dear Sir/Madam.

Belgium very much welcomes the Commission's Green Paper on passive smoking and regards smoke-free policy as a high priority. Therefore the Belgian authorities would like to send in a reply to the questions raised in the Green Paper.

However, within less than two weeks federal elections are taking place. Being such an important item, the way forward on smoke-free policies will be determined within the framework of the new coalition agreement. This implies that the authorities will not be able to take a position on this subject for as long as negotiations on the new coalition agreement are not finished.

Consequently the Belgian authorities would like to ask for a postponement of the deadline for replying to the Green Paper until the 1st of August 2007.

Is this feasible?
