I am a non-smoker. When I go to a restaurant at lunchtime, there should be no smoking at lunchtime. When I go to a nightclub in the evening, nightclubs are an exception.

Where the pan-European ban on smoking is concerned, I would overturn the ban on smoking outdoors in front of bars. It would be better to let smokers have dedicated areas – hotel rooms, an outdoor ashtray in front of a bar or a terrace.
