- Tools & mechanisms for skills development – Know-how



Working definition of social inequities in health

 Whitehead & Dahlgren that practically all health differences in Europe are socially determined.

We use the term social inequities and consider it synonymous to inequalities and variations in health, in the context of this project.



Working definition of social determinants of health

The social determinants of health encompass the full set of social conditions in which people live and work.
