## Follow up of the Health Strategy

- Background: Main purpose of the group and a unique opportunity to advise the new Commission and Commissioner on Health regarding the Health Strategy
- Aim: Identify progress and gaps in the implementation of the Health Strategy and ensure learning from experience gained through the Health programme

#### <u>Input</u>

- Commission report
- Inventory of MS' views
- Stakeholders?

#### **Output**

- Strategic exchange of views regarding how to strengthen the Health Strategy
- Conclusions in a report/non paper



## Health System Performance Assessment

- <u>Background</u>: Decision-makers face a series of common problems as they aim to improve the performance of their health systems.
- <u>Aim</u>: Elaborate around the concept, share experiences and discuss how the structure and decisions regarding system development can be more knowledge based and how it could be organized.



### Health Systems Performance Assessment

#### <u>Input</u>

- Commission report
- Pre-distributed questions to the Member States
- Stakeholders?

#### **Output**

- Exchange of good practices
- To give the incoming Commission ideas of necessary Community tools to promote knowledge based structure and decisions about system development
- Conclusions in a report/non paper
