Albanian health system have to perform a difficult balancing act, firstly between basic needs, increasing demands on health services and restricted supply, secondly between the need to respond to people's health needs in quality service but also to be prepared for public health crises.

In the "Green Paper on the Europe Workforce for Health", we see un opportunity to describe as precisely as possible the challenges faced by the Albanians health workforce which are comme to differences countries in regions and to understand our differences in rapport with Member States countries.

We belive than to approve this "Green Paper", we will understand better our problems in the health work force and identify where the EU can help us to lunch a debate and to resolve it.

We considers the collaboration with EU and SEE countries is very important in this process.
