1. Background (to the call for monitoring of the Dublin Declaration)



2 nd Q 2001	UNGASS Declaration of Commitment
1 st Q 2004	Irish presidency to the EU: Breaking the Barriers: Partnership to Fight HIV/AIDS in Europe and Central Asia
2 nd Q 2004	EU Council calls for vigorous follow-up of Dublin Decl.
2006	German MoH provides funds for 'one-off' follow-up of DD lead by WHO/EURO under the auspices of UNAIDS
4 th Q 2007	EU COM calls on ECDC to construct a framework to monitor the DD in order to ensure sustainable monitoring
1 st Q 2008	Draft framework developed & presented to the EU Think Tank on HIV/AIDS
3 rd Q 2008	WHO/EURO Report on implementation of DD published
4 th Q 2008	ECDC tender awarded
1 st Q 2009	First advisory-group meeting at ECDC

2. Overall purpose

The overall purpose of the ECDC advisory-group:

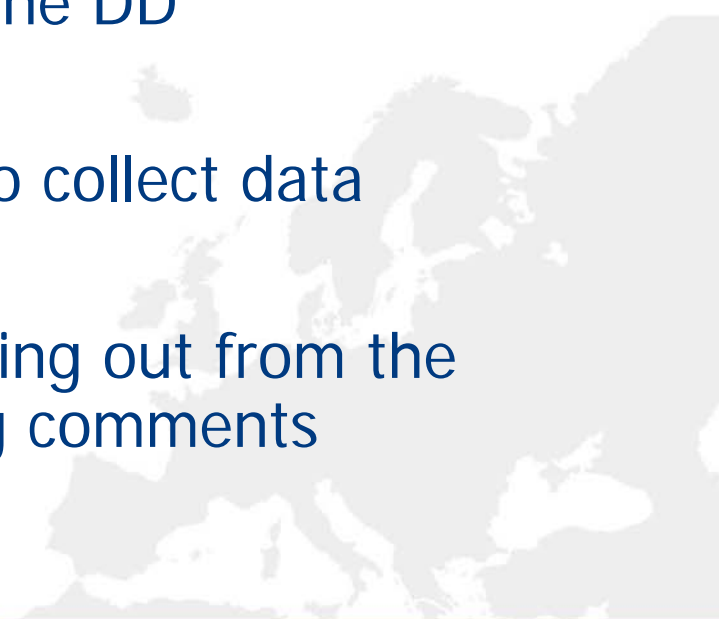
“...support the development of an indicator-based and country-driven report on the monitoring of progress in implementing the actions set out in the Dublin Declaration”



3. Main tasks

The main tasks of the advisory-group is to advise ECDC in the:

- development of the monitoring framework
- selection of indicators to monitor the DD
- construction of the ECDC survey to collect data
- review of all draft documents coming out from the monitoring activities and providing comments

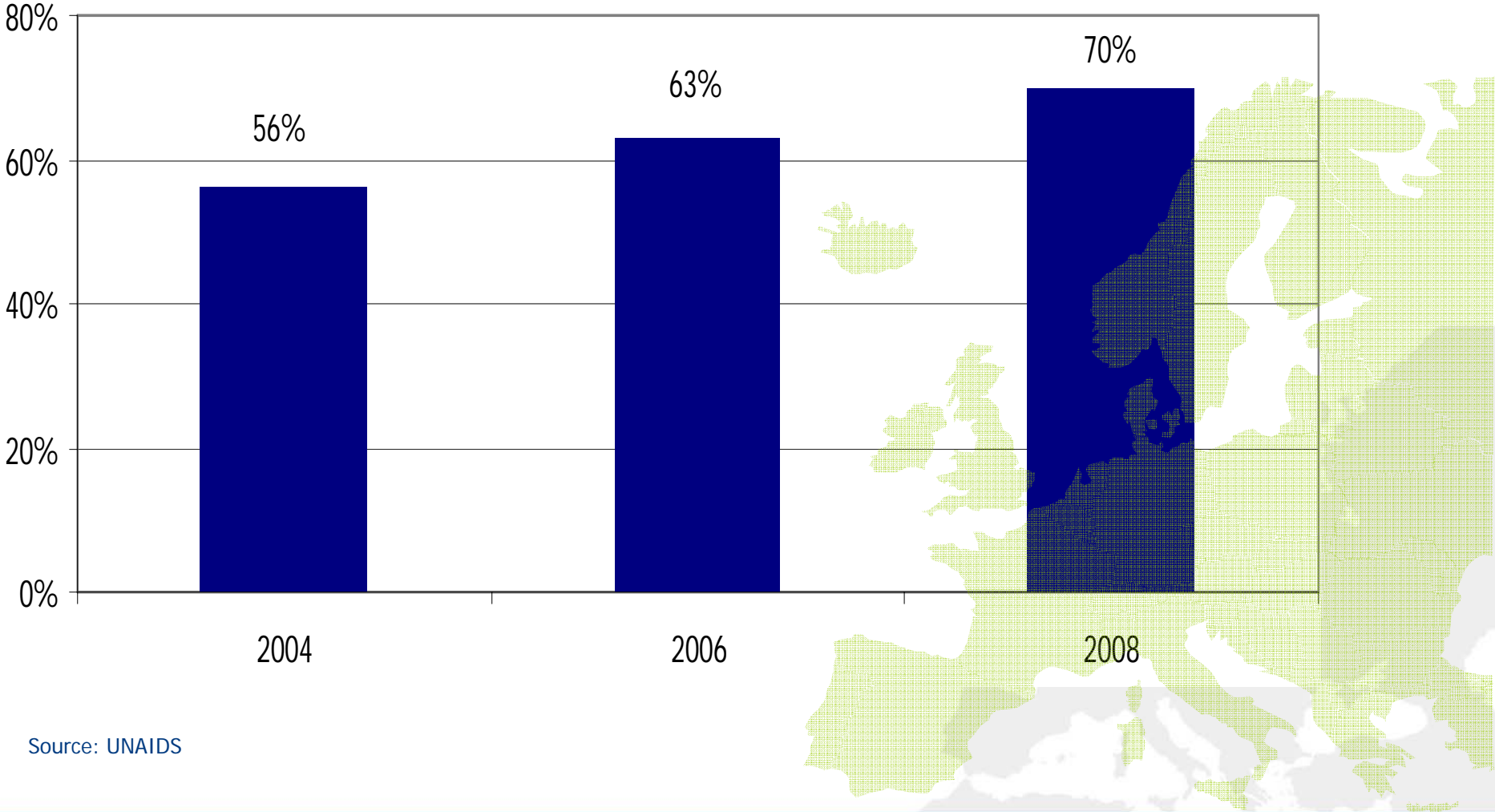
