Legal framework for Community preparedness for nuclear emergencies

- EURATOM treaty is the legal basis for all Community radiation protection competence
- Derived legislation:
 - » Directive on EU Basic Safety Standards
 - Souncil Decision on early exchange of information
 - » Directive on emergency foodstuffs regulations
 - » Directives on information to the public

Commission role in a radiological emergency


- *In legal terms* the Commission has a limited role in a radiological emergency situation:
 - » Early exchange of information (ECURIE)
 - » Community emergency foodstuff regulations
- In practise the Commission will also face the following tasks:
 - Information to the public through the media
 - > Respond to information and assistance requests
 - >> Preparation for political action

EURDEP


» Automatic exchange of radiation monitoring data
